SIZES

Finished bust circumference: 30 (34, 38, 42, 46)" Length: 17¾ (17¾, 18¾, 18¾, 20½)" Sweater shown measures 34".

MATERIALS

Manos del Uruguay SILK BLEND (70% extrafine merino wool, 30% silk; approx. 50g/150 yds), 7 (7, 8, 9, 10) sk

Shown in #3203 Tomato

US H-8/5mm crochet hook, or 2 sizes smaller than size needed to obtain gauge.

US J-10/6mm crochet hook, or size needed to obtain gauge.

removable stitch marker tapestry needle

GAUGE

16 sts and 9 rows = 4" in Hdc-blo with larger hook.

NOTES

• The RS and WS of this piece look very similar. When beginning the front sleeves, place a removable marker into the fabric on the RS to easily tell the difference between them.

ABBREVIATIONS

blo: back loop only RS: right side st(s): stitch(es) WS: wrong side yo: yarn over


CROCHET STITCHES


ch: (crochet chain) *wrap yarn around crochet hook and draw it through the loop on the hook to form the first chain; repeat from * as many times as instructed. (The loop on the hook is never included when counting the number of chains)

Fhdc: (Foundation half-double crochet) ch3, yo and insert hook in third ch from hook, pull up a loop (3 loops on hook), yo and pull through first loop only, yo and pull through all 3 loops [I st complete]; *yo and insert hook into "chain" at the bottom of the last completed st, yo and pull through first loop, yo and pull through all 3 loops [I additional st complete]; repeat from * for desired number of stitches.

hdc: (half double crochet) Yo, insert hook into indicated stitch, yo and pull up a loop; yo and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

sc: (single crochet) insert crochet hook in indicated stitch, yo and pull up a loop; yo and draw through both loops on hook





STITCH GUIDE

Hdc-blo Pattern (over any number of sts)

Set-up Row: Hdc-blo of third ch from hook and in each ch to end, turn.

Row 1: Ch 2 (does not count as a st), hdc-blo of first hdc and each hdc to end, turn.

Rep Row I for pattern.

INSTRUCTIONS

BACK

With larger hook, ch 62 (70, 78, 86, 94).

Work Set-up Row of Hdc-blo Pattern. [60 (68, 76, 84, 92) hdc]

Work Row I of Hdc-blo Pattern 22 (22, 23, 23, 25) times. [Piece should measure about 10¼ (10¼, 10¾, 10¾, 11½)" from beginning.]

Fasten off.

Shape Sleeves

Set-up Row: With smaller hook, Fhdc for 32 (32, 33, 34, 35) sts; change to larger hook and work 60 (68, 76, 84, 92) back sts; change to smaller hook and Fhdc 32 (32, 33, 34, 35) sts. [124 (132, 142, 152, 162) hdc]

Work Row I of Hdc-blo Pattern 16 (16, 17, 17, 19) times. [Piece should measure about 7½ (7½, 8, 8, 9)" from beginning of sleeves.]
Fasten off.

FRONT

With larger hook, ch | 54 (170, 187, 204, 221).

Work Set-up Row of Hdc-blo Pattern. [152 (168, 185, 202, 219) hdc]

Work Row I of Hdc-blo Pattern I7 (17, 18, 18, 20) times. [Piece should measure about 8 $(8, 8\frac{1}{2}, 8\frac{1}{2}, 9\frac{1}{4})$ " from beginning.]



Divide One Sleeve

Next Row (RS): Work Hdc-blo Pattern for 120 (136, 152, 168, 184) sts then turn, leaving remaining 32 (32, 33, 34, 35) sts unworked for sleeve.

Work Hdc-blo Pattern for 4 rows over these 120 (136, 152, 168, 184) sts, ending after a RS row.

Add Second Sleeve

Next Row (WS): Work Hdc-blo over 120 (136, 152, 168, 184) sts, then change to smaller hook and Fhdc 32 (32, 33, 34, 35) sts. [142 (158, 185, 202, 219) hdc]

Change to larger hook and work Hdc-blo Pattern for 17 (17, 18, 18, 19) rows. [Piece should measure about 8 (8, 8½, 8½, 9¼)" from beginning of second sleeve]
Fasten off.

FINISHING

Block pieces to measuremenst.

Flold I sleeve of front so tops of front sleeves align with the tops of the back sleeves, creating a central twist on the front. Sew shoulders seams leaving 8" back neck opening, then sew side seams and underarms. With larger hook, work a rnd of sc around each sleeve opening. Weave in ends.
