- Size Medium is pictured in the pattern. It is a generously sized adult scarf.

- Size Small will be a short scarf - you can throw it over your shoulder, but it will not wrap around your neck. If you'd like the width of the Small size, but a scarf that will wrap once around your neck, purchase I skein of a 7th (or 7th and 8th) color. After completing Section 5, work Section 2 again (or Sections 2 and 3) to incorporate your additional color(s). When you are ready for your final color, work Section 6 as written. 7 colors will produce a 57³/4" long scarf (about average).

MATERIALS

Manos del Uruguay SILK BLEND (70% extrafine merino wool, 30% silk, kettle dyed; approx 50g/150yds), 1 sk each Colors A and F, 1(2) sks each Colors B, C, D and E. Shown in #300G Coffee (A); #3044 Briar (B); #3019 Dove (C); #3082 Shocking (D); #3202 Zinnia (E); #3203 Tomato (F).

US 5/3.75mm ndls or size to obtain gauge tapestry needle

GAUGE 21 sts and 42 rows = 4" in Garter Stitch.



ABBREVIATIONS CO: cast on decr: decrease incr: increase k: knit k1 fb: knit 1 into the front and back of same stitch k2tog: knit 2 stitches together ndl(s): needle(s) RS: right side ssk: slip 2 stitches, 1 at a time, knitwise to the right needle. Return stitches to the left needle in turned position then knit them together through the back loops

st(s): stitch(es)

STITCH GUIDE

Garter Stitch (over any number of sts) Knit all sts, every row. INSTRUCTIONS SECTION I With Color A, CO I st. Set-up Row I (RS): KIfb. [2 sts] Set-up Rows 2 and 4: Knit. Set-up Row 3: KIfb, kI. [3 sts]

Incr Row (RS): Knit to last 2 sts, k1fb, k1. [1 st increased] Knit 1 WS row. Repeat the last 2 rows 28 (47, 60) times more. 32 (51)

Decr Row (RS): Knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1. [1 st decreased] Knit 1 WS row. Repeat the last 2 rows 39 (48) times more. [2 sts remain]

Next Row (RS): K2tog. [I st remains] Break yarn and fasten off.



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SECTION 2

With RS of Section I facing, use Color B to pick up and knit 62 (100) sts (approx. I st in each garter ridge) along longest edge of Section I (see diagram).

Knit I WS row.

Decr Row (RS): KI, ssk, knit to end. [I st decreased] Knit I WS row. Repeat the last 2 rows 59 (97) times more. [2 sts remain]

Next Row (RS): Ssk. [1 st remains] Break yarn and fasten off.

SECTION 3

With RS of Section 2 facing, use Color C to pick up and knit 62 (100) sts (1 st in each garter ridge) along edge of Section 2 (see diagram). Knit 1 WS row.

Decr Row (RS): Knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1. [1 st decreased] Knit 1 WS row. Repeat the last 2 rows 59 (97) times more. [2 sts remain]

Next Row (RS): K2tog. [I st remains] Break yarn and fasten off.

SECTION 4

With RS of Section 3 facing, use Color D to pick up and knit 62 (100, 126) sts (1 st in each garter ridge) along edge of Section 3 (see diagram). Knit 1 WS row. Continue same as Section 2.

SECTION 5

With RS of Section 4 facing, use Color E to pick up and knit 62 (100) sts (1 st in each garter ridge) along edge of Section 4 (see diagram). Knit 1 WS row.

Continue same as Section 3.

SECTION 6

With RS of Section 5 facing, use Color F to pick up and knit 62 (100) sts (1 st in each garter ridge) along edge of Section 5 (see diagram). Knit 1 WS row.


Decr Row (RS): K1, ssk, knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1. [2 sts decreased] Knit 1 WS row. Repeat the last 2 rows 28 (47) times more. [4 sts remain]

Next Row (RS): Ssk, k2tog. [2 sts remain] Knit I WS row.

Next Row (RS). K2tog. [I st remains] Break yarn and fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Block to measurements.
