



MANOS DEL URUGUAY

Elizabethtown

SIZE

Circumference: 26" at base, 16" at neck

Length: 8" with collar unfolded

MATERIALS

Manos del Uruguay WOOL CLASICA (100g, approx. 138 yds; 100% wool), 1 sk. Shown in 55 Olive.

US 10/6mm 16" circular ndl, OR SIZE TO OBTAIN

GAUGE

2 cable needles

Marker

Button

GAUGE

20 sts and 24 rows = 4"/10 cm in Cable Pattern

ABBREVIATIONS

C6fp1 = slip 3 sts to cn and hold at front of work; sll to cn and hold at back of work; k3 from LH ndl, p1 from back cn, k3 from front cn.

C4decfp1 = slip 3 sts to cn and hold at front of work; sll to cn and hold at back of work; (k2tog, k1) from LH ndl, p1 from back cn, (k2tog, k1) from front cn.

C2decfp1 = slip 2 sts to cn and hold in front of work; sll to cn and hold at back of work; k2tog from LH ndl, p1 from back cn, k2tog from front cn.

INSTRUCTIONS

CO 128 sts. Join, being careful not to twist, and pm to show beg of rnd.

Rnds 1-3: *K3, p1; rep from * to end of rnd.

Rnd 4: *(K3, p1) twice, C6fp1, p1; rep from * to end of rnd.

Rnds 5-7: as Rnd 1.

Rnd 8: *C6fp1, p1, (k3, p1) twice; rep from * to end of rnd.

Beg decs:

Rnds 9-11: *K3, p1; rep from * to end of rnd.

Rnd 12: *(K3, p1) twice, C4decfp1, p1; rep from * to end of rnd.

Rnds 13-15: *(K3, p1) twice, (k2, p1) twice; rep from * to end of rnd.

Rnd 16: *C4decfp1, p1, (k2, p1) twice; rep from * to end of rnd.

Rnds 17-19: *K2, p1; rep from * to end of rnd.

Rnd 20: *(K2, p1) twice, C2decfp1, p1; rep from * to end of rnd.

Rnds 21-23: *(K2, p1) twice, (k1, p1) twice; rep from * to end of rnd.

Rnd 22: *C2decfp1, p1, (k1, p1) twice; rep from * to end of rnd.

Rnds 23-25: *K1, p1; rep from * to end of rnd. 64 sts rem.

Begin working back and forth for collar. *K1, P1; rep to end of row. Next row: Use a cable cast-on to CO 6 sts. Cont working in K1, P1 rib until 4 rows have been worked. Work buttonhole: K1, P1, yo, k2tog, p1, rib to end. Cont in rib for 4 more rows. BO in rib.

Sew 6 cast-on sts to the inside of the first 6 sts of collar, being sure that the buttonhole is on the outside. Sew button opposite buttonhole. Weave in ends.
