



MANOS DEL URUGUAY

Nahasane

SIZE

Circumference: 18"

Length: 10" (excluding earflaps), 14" (including earflaps)

MATERIALS

Manos del Uruguay WOOL CLASICA (100g, approx. 138 yds; 100% wool); 1 sk each A and B. Shown in 701 (A), Q Calypso (B)

US7/4.5 mm dpn and 16" circ ndl , OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE

GAUGE

17 sts and 20 rows = 4"/10 cm in St st over fairisle patt

ABBREVIATION

ssptbl = sl next 2 sts, one at a time, knitwise; return to left ndl; then p2tog tbl.

INSTRUCTIONS

Using DPNs, CO 8 sts, dividing evenly onto 4 ndls. Change to circ ndl and pm to show beg of rnd when comfortable.

Rnd 1: K. Rnd 2: M1 in each stitch — 16 sts.

Rnd 3: K. Rnd 4: *M1, k1; rep from * around — 24 sts.

Rnds 5 and 6: K.

Rnd 7: *M1, k2; rep from * around.

Rnd 8 and 9: K.

Rnd 10: *M1, k3; rep from * around.

Rnds 12 and 13: K. Cont to inc in this way (8 sts every 3rd rnd) to 72 sts. Work even for 3".

Work 11 rnds of chart patt. Work 4 rnds of garter stitch (i.e. k 1 rnd, p 1 rnd).

Earflaps

BO 11. K until there are 16 sts on RH ndl. Turn; work back and forth on these 16 sts.

Rows 1, 3, 5, and 7 (RS): K.

Rows 2, 4, 6, and 8: K2, p12, k2.

Rows 9, 11, 13, and 15: K2, ssk, k to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2.

Rows 10, 12, and 14: K2, p to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 16: K2, p2tog, ssptbl, k2.

Row 17: K1, s2kp, k1.

Row 18: S2kp.

Fasten off. Reattach yarn to live stitches on other side of earflap sts; BO 18. Rep earflap over next 16 sts. Reattach yarn to remaining 11 sts, BO.

Finishing

Cut 4 1-yd lengths of A and 5 1-yard lengths of B. Hold 3 strands together and thread through center point of earflap. Adjust length so ends are even. Divide the 6 strands into three groups and braid loosely for 9". Tie all 6 strands in a knot and trim ends, leaving 1" tails. Repeat for second earflap. Thread the remaining 3 strands through the top of the hat, down one side of the CO into the center of the hat and back up through the opposite side of the cast on. Braid for 2" and finish off as for earflaps. Weave in ends and block.
