LYS exclusive until 1/1/2023

SIZF

20" neck circumference x 15" at deepest point

MATERIALS

Manos del Uruguay FELIZ (70% superwash merino, 30% modal; approx. 100g/350 yds): I sk each of A and B. Shown in Z2045 I Cantaloupe (A) and Z9042 Sunset (B).

OR

Manos del Uruguay MILO (65% merino wool, 35% linen; approx 100g/380 yds): I sk each of A and B. Shown in i8135 Rainbow (A) and i2622 Amatista (B).

US 6/4.0mm 16" circular needle, or size needed to obtain gauge

3 stitch markers Tapestry needle

GAUGE

22 sts and 30 rows = 4"/10cm in Stockinette stitch and garter

ABBREVIATIONS

BOR: Beginning of Round

CDD: central double decrease. Insert right-hand needle knitwise as if to k2tog and slip 2 sts, k1, pass 2 slipped stitches over as one (2 stitches decreased)

k: knit

k2tog: knit 2 stitches together (1 stitch decreased) m: marker(s)

mIL: insert left needle under horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from the front to the back, knit through the back loop (I st increased)

mIR: insert left needle under horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from the back to the front, knit through the front loop (1 st increased)

p: purl

pm: place marker
rnd(s): round(s)

sl: slip

slm: slip marker

ssk: slip 2 stitches, I at a time, knitwise to the right needle. Return stitches to the left needle in turned position then knit them together through the back loops (I stitch decreased) st(s): stitch(es)



INSTRUCTIONS

SET UP:

With A, cast on 3 sts.

Row I-6: Knit.

Row 7: With B, k3, pm, pick up and knit 3 sts from the left side edge of work, pm, pick up and knit 3 sts from the cast-on edge. (9 sts)

Row 8: K3, slm, p2, pm, p1, slm, k3.

Flat Pattern:

Row I (RS): K3, slm, yo, k to m, mIL, slm, kI, mIR, k to m, yo, slm, k3. (4 sts increased)

Row 2 (WS): K3, p to last 3 sts, k3.

Repeat rows 1-2, changing yarn color between repeats at random.

- I used a random-number generator app to randomize how many repeats (rows I-2) of a color I was going to work, with a maximum of 4. A common 6-sided die would also work well.
- Exact color sequences shown are listed in the chart below.

Work the Flat Pattern until the bottom edge (side with no live sts) is 22" across, unstretched, about 149 sts. This will become your neck circumference (and also the part that goes over your head).



Transition:

Break yarn. SI3, slm (this is now your BOR), and continue with opposite yarn color:

Rnd 1: Ssk, k to m, m | L, slm, k |, m | R, k to 2 sts before m, k2tog, slm, k |, k2tog, do not turn work!, continue in the rnd - ssk, k |, ending at the BOR. (2 sts decreased)

Rnd 2: K to last m, slm, k1, k2tog, k1. (1 st decreased)

Rnd 3: Ssk, k to m, m \mid L, slm, k \mid , m \mid R, k to 2 sts before m,

k2tog, slm, CDD. (2 sts decreased)

Rnd 4: Knit.

Change yarn color.

Pattern In-the-Rnd:

Rnd I: Ssk, k to m, mIL, slm, kI, mIR, k to 2 sts before m, k2tog, slm, kI.

Rnd 2: Knit.

Repeat rnds 1-2, changing yarn color between repeats at random as before.

- Exact color sequences shown are listed in the chart below.

Work the Pattern In-the-Rnd until the piece measures about 4" from the join.

Border:

Change needle size for garter gauge if necessary. Continue with the opposite yarn color.

Rnd 1: Ssk, k to m, m | L, slm, k |, m | R, k to 2 sts before m, k2tog, slm, k |.

Rnd 2: Purl.

Repeat these two rnds 4 more times.

Bind off knitwise.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Block if desired.

Rows 9-12: A
Rows 13-18: B
Rows 19-22: A
Rows 23-24: B
Rows 25-30: A
Rows 31-38: B
Rows 39-40: A

Transition:

Rnds I-4: B

Rows 41-46: B

Rows 47-52: A

Rows 53-56: B

Rows 57-58: A

Rows 59-66: B

Rows 67-74: A

In-the-Rnd Section:

Rnds 1-2: A Rnds 3-4: B Rnds 5-10: A Rnds 11-18: B Rnds 19-22: A

Border: Rnds I-10: B

Flat Section: Rows 1-6: B

Rows 7-12: A Rows 13-16: B

Rows 17-18: A

Rows 19-22: B

Rows 23-30: A

Rows 31-34: B

Rows 35-40: A

Rows 41-48: B

Rows 49-54: A

Rows 55-58: B

Rows 59-60: A

Rows 61-64: B

Rows 65-70: A

Transition:

Rnds I-4: B

In-the-Rnd Section:

Rnds I-2: A

Rnds 3-8: B

Rnds 9-12: A

Rnds 13-14: B

Rnds 15-18: A

Rnds 19-24: B

Border:

Rnds I-10: A
