

MANOS DEL URUGUAY

Twined Flowers

SIZE

7.5" wide \times 90" long

MATERIALS

Manos del Uruguay FELIZ (70% merino superwash, 30% modal; approx. 100g/350 yds), 2 sk (MC) and FINO (70% merino extrafine, 30% silk; approx. 100g/490 yds), 1 sk (CC). Shown in Z8931 Wildflowers (MC) with 416 Amethyst Earring (CC).

US 6/4mm ndl, or size to obtain gauge 2 ring markers Tapestry needle

GAUGE

24 sts and 44 rows = 4" in Garter St

ABBREVIATIONS

CC: contrast color

k: knit

MC: main color ndl: needle rep: repeat st(s): stitch(es)

w&t: slip next st purlwise to right ndl; bring yarn between ndls to front of work; slip st from right ndl back to left ndl; turn the work around. When you reach the wrapped st on the following row, insert point of right ndl into wrap from below and then into st, and knit together the wrap with the st.

STITCH GUIDE

Striped Wedge (over 45 sts)

Row I (CC): KI5, w&t.

Row 2 (CC): Knit.

Rows 3 and 4 (MC): Knit.

Row 5 (CC): K30, w&t.

Row 6 (CC): Knit.

Rows 7 and 8 (MC): Knit.

Rep rows I-8 for Striped Wedge.

INSTRUCTIONS

With MC, cast on 45 sts. Knit one row, placing markers after 15th and 30th sts. Join CC and work Striped Wedge 68 times, then work rows 1-7 once more.

Cut CC and rejoin at edge where working yarn (MC) is. Note: For the second half of the scarf, odd-numbered rows will begin on the "wrong" side of the work, and the stripes will have a slightly different appearance. This is a design element, not a mistake. Beginning with Row I, work Striped Wedge 68 times, then work rows I-7 once more. With MC, bind off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Steam-block if desired.
