

Whizdinger

SIZES

13" × 66"

MATERIALS

Manos del Uruguay MILO (65% merino wool, 35% linen, approx. 100 g/380 yds), 1 sk each of 3 colors.

Shown in i21561 Argan (C1), i2428 Nautilus (C2), and i2800

Natural (C3).

US 6/4.25mm needles, or size to obtain gauge

Approx. 18 ring markers

Tapestry needle

GAUGE

22 stitches and 40 rows = 4" in Garter st, i.e. knit every row

NOTES

At the short-row gap, knit together the head of the stitch directly underneath the stitch on the right needle with the first stitch on the left needle. This closes the gap neatly. Do not cut yarn until told to do so. Carry unused color up side of work.

ABBREVIATIONS

CI: color I

C2: color 2

C3: color 3

k: knit

m: marker(s)

p: purl

pm: place marker

rep: repeat(s), repeating rem: remain(s), remaining

RS: right side st(s): stitch(es) WS: wrong side



INSTRUCTIONS

Using CI, cast on 72 sts.

Knit 2 rows.

** Part I

Row I (RS): Join C3 and k until 4 sts rem. Turn. K4, pm, knit to end.

Row 2: With CI, k to m. Turn. K4, pm, knit to end.

Repeat rows I and 2 until 8 sts rem on right ndl, ending after Row 2.

Cut C3.

RS: With C1, k to end of row, removing m and closing gaps as you come to them.

Part II.

Row I (WS): With CI, k until 4 sts rem. Turn. K4, pm, knit to end.

Row 2: Continuing with CI, k to m. Turn. K4, pm, knit to end. Repeat rows I and 2 until 8 st rem on right ndl, ending after Row 2.

(WS) K to end of row.

Join C2. With C1 and C2, rep Part I, cutting C1 at end.

With C2, rep Part II.

Join C3. With C3 and C2, rep Part I, cutting C2 at end

With C3, rep Part II. **

Rep from ** to ** 4 more times.

(RS) Bind off knitwise.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Block lightly if desired.
