

Pips Scarf

SIZES

Approximately 5" wide x 90" long

MATERIALS

Manos del Uruguay FRANCA (100% superwash merino; approx. 114 yds/150 g): 1 sk each of colors A and B. Shown in F62220 Gold Drop (A), and F9053 Gold Nugget (B).

US 17 / 12 mm straight or circular, or size to obtain gauge. Tapestry needle

Large crochet hook for fringe

GAUGE

9 stitches and 15 rows = 4" in garter stitch Please note, the scarf will stretch lengthwise almost as soon as it is bound off.

STITCH GUIDE

Transition B:

Row 1 & 2: Using Color B, knit. Row 3 & 4: Using Color A, knit.

Transition A:

Row I & 2: Using Color A, knit. Row 3 & 4: Using Color B, knit.



INSTRUCTIONS

Using Color A, cast on 13 stitches.

Knit 26 rows.

Work 'Transition B' three times.

Break Color A.

Using Color B, knit 32 rows.

Work 'Transition A' twice.

Break Color B.

Using Color A, knit 32 rows.

Work 'Transition B' once.

Break Color A.

Using Color B, knit 46 rows.

Work 'Transition A' once.

Break Color B.

Using Color A, knit 32 rows.

Work 'Transition B' twice.

Break Color A.

Using Color B, knit 32 rows.

Work 'Transition A' three times.

Break Color B.

Using Color A, knit 26 rows.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Break yarn, fasten off, and weave in ends.

Cut 24 pieces of fringe I 5" long of each color. Attach I strand of each color of fringe in between every stitch at each end of the scarf.

Trim ends of fringe even.
