

# Everyday Handwarmers

#### SI7F

Adult Medium (7" circumference  $\times$  8" length; handwarmers are very stretchy)

#### **MATERIALS**

Manos del Uruguay ALEGRIA GRANDE (75% superwash merino, 25% polyamide; approx. 197 yds / 180m per 3.5 oz / 100g), I sk. Shown in AG2121 Cinnamon.

US 8/5mm needle Tapestry needle

## **GAUGE**

17 sts = 4" over Garter Stitch

## NOTE

To keep things simple, these instructions call for a regular cast-on and a sewn seam. If you're feeling more adventurous, however, this is a great spot for a provisional cast-on and a grafted seam. Knitter's choice!

## **INSTRUCTIONS**

Right Handwarmer

Cast on 37 stitches.

Row I (right side): Knit.

Row 2: Slip 2 stitches with yarn in front; knit 13; slip 2 with yarn in front; knit 17; slip 3 with yarn in front.

Repeat rows I and 2 until piece measures 3", ending having just worked Row I.

## Thumb hole:

Slip 2 with yarn in front, knit 3, bind off 5 stitches, knit 4, slip 2 with yarn in front, knit 17, slip 3 with yarn in front.

Next row: Knit to gap; use a knitted cast-on to cast on 6 stitches; knit 1; pass last cast-on stitch over knit stitch; knit to end of row.

Continue in pattern as before, beginning with Row 2. When piece measures  $6\frac{3}{4}$ ", bind off on right side. Cut yarn, leaving a 2-foot tail for seaming.

## Left Handwarmer

Cast on 37 stitches.

Row I (right side): Knit.

Row 2: Slip 3 stitches with yarn in front, knit 17, slip 2 with yarn in front, knit 13, slip 2 with yarn in front.

Repeat rows I and 2 until piece measures 3", ending having just worked Row 2.

## Thumb hole:

Knit 5, bind off 5, knit to end of row.

Next row: Slip 3 with yarn in front, knit 17, slip 2 with yarn in front, knit to gap; use a knitted-on cast-on to cast on 6 stitches; knit 1; pass last cast-on stitch over knit stitch; knit to last 2 stitches; slip 2 with yarn in front.

Continue in pattern as before, beginning with Row I. When piece measures  $6\frac{3}{4}$ ", bind off on right side. Cut yarn, leaving a 2-foot tail for seaming.

# FINISHING

Sew seam. Weave in ends.
