1. Alumroot

(*Hechera richardsonii*) Flowers in a dense spike, 30-50 cm tall, blooms in June. Will tolerate shade. Leaves form clumps. Seeds or plants.

2. Lindley's Aster

(*Aster ciliolatus*) Purple daisy like flowers with a yellow center, 30-75 cm tall, blooms August to September. Seeds or plants.

3. Smooth Aster

(*Aster laevis*) Purple daisy like flowers with a yellow center, grows 30-90 cm tall, blooms August to September. Seeds or plants.

4. Bergamot

Monarda fistulosa Pink flowers, 45 to 90 cm tall, blooms July and August. Powdery mildew can be a problem in humid areas. Seeds or plants.

5. Black-eyed Susan

(*Rubdeckia hirta*) Yellow petals with dark center, 30-45 cm tall, blooms July to September. Self seeds. Seeds or plants.

6. Dotted Blazingstar

(*Liatrus punctata*) Rose colour blossoms in a dense flower spike, 20-60 cm tall, blooms July to September. Seeds or plants.

7. Meadow Blazingstar

(*Liatrus ligulistylis*) Pink to lilac flower heads arranged in a spike, 30-76 cm tall, blooms July and August. Seeds or plants.

8. Gaillardia

(*Gaillardia aristata*) Showy, yellow flowers with red centre, 20-60 cm tall blooms July and August. Seeds or plants.

9. Giant Hyssop

(*Agastache foeniculum*) Violet coloured flower spike, 30-90 cm tall, blooms July and August. Anise scented. Seeds or plants.

10. Golden Bean

(*Thermopsis rhombifolia*) Golden yellow pea shaped flowers, grows 10 to 40 cm tall, blooms May to June. Seeds.

11. Stiff Goldenrod

(*Solidago rigida*) Yellow flowers, 10-40 cm tall, blooms August to early October. Add bright colour to fall garden. Seeds or plants.

12. Harebell

(*Campanula rotundifolia*) Delicate blue bell shaped flowers, 10-45 cm tall, blooms June to September. Seeds or plants.

13. Long Fruited Anemone

(*Anemone cylindrical*) White to light pink flower, grows 15-50 cm tall, blooms May and June. Has a white, woolly seed head. Aggressive.

14. Northern Bedstraw

(*Galium boreale*) White clusters of sweet smelling flowers, 20 -50 cm tall blooms in June. Nice ground cover. Aggressive. Seeds or plants.

15. Northern Hedysarum

(*Hedysarum boreale*) White to pink pea like flowers, 20-80 cm tall, blooms May and June. Aggressive. Seeds or plants.

16. Purple Prairie Clover

(*Dalea purpureum*) Purple column shaped flowers, grows up to 40 cm tall, blooms from July to September. Roots fix nitrogen. Seeds.

17. White Prairie Clover

(*Dalea canna*) White column shaped flowers, grows up to 40 cm tall, blooms from July to September. Roots fix nitrogen. Seeds or plants.

18. Prairie Coneflower

(*Ratibida columnifera*) Yellow petals with brown cone shaped center, 30-60 cm tall, blooms, July to September. Seeds or plants.

19. Prairie Crocus

(*Anemone patens*) Cup shaped purple flower, 10-30 cm tall, blooms mid-April to June. May take 3 years to bloom. Seeds or plants.

20. Scarlet Mallow

(*Malvastrum coccineum*) Pale orange to brick red flower, 15-20 cm tall, blooms May to July. Drought tolerant. Seeds

21. Scarlet Paintbrush

(*Castilleja miniata*) Showy pink to red flowers, 30-60 cm tall, blooms July to August. Difficult to get established. Seeds.

22. Slender Beardtongue

(*Penstemon procerus*) Small lavender flowers in a compact flower spike, 15 to 45 cm tall, blooms, May to July. Seeds.

23. Three Flowered Avenas

(*Geum triflorum*) Nodding reddish brown flowers, usually in threes, 15-40 cm tall, blooms May to July. Feathery seed head. Seeds or plants.

24. Western Red Lily

(*Lilium philadelphicum*) Scarlet-orange flowers, 20-76 cm tall, blooms July and August. Floral emblem of Saskatchewan. Seeds or plants.

25. Wild Blue Flax

(*Linum lewisii*) Dainty, sky blue flowers, 20-70 cm tall, blooms each morning June to August. Very easy to grow. Seeds or plants.

26. Yellow Evening Primrose

(*Oenothera biennis*) Yellow flowers, 50-150 cm tall, blooms July to September. Blooms from evening to sunrise. Seeds.

27. Butterfly Garden Mix

Attract butterflies to your garden or yard. All wildflower species in this mix are native to Saskatchewan and relatively easy to grow. Contains (in alphabetic order): Bergamot, Black-eyed Susan, Dotted Blazing Star, Gaillardia, Hyssop, Lindley's Aster, Meadow Blazingstar, Mountain Goldenrod, Northern Hedysarum, Prairie Coneflower, Purple Prairie Clover, White Prairie Clover, Wild Blue Flax, and Yellow Evening Primrose. The 25 g package contains enough seed to plant 20 square meters and costs \$20.

28. Prairie Wildflower Mix

The Prairie wildflower mix offers a range of colours and flowering dates. Contains (in alphabetic order): Black-eyed Susan, Dotted Blazing Star, Gaillardia, Harebell, Hyssop, Mountain Goldenrod, Prairie Coneflower, Purple Prairie Clover, Slender Blue Beardtongue, Stiff Goldenrod, Velvety Goldenrod, Yarrow, and Yellow Evening Primrose. The 25 g package contains enough seed to plant 20 square meters and costs \$20.
