What are Cookies?

Cookies are small pieces of text and stored in your web browser. You can find out more about cookies by visiting www.allaboutcookies.org. If you are located in the European Union you may use the resources at www.youronlinechoices.eu. Their purpose is to allow the Service or third-party to recognize you and make your next visit easier and the Service more useful to you. Cookies can help a website to arrange content to match your preferred interests more quickly but cannot be used by themselves to identify you.

Our Use of Cookies

When you use and access our websites, we may place a number of cookies files in your web browser. We use cookies to help us recognise you, to improve your experience, increase security and measure use of our Services. We may also use cookies to ensure that content from our websites is presented in the most effective manner for you and your computer or mobile device and to enable certain functions of the Service such as to enable advertisements delivery.

We use four types of cookies to run the Service:

- Strictly Necessary Cookies which are essential for the operation of our website because they
 enable you to navigate the website and use all the features and to enable you to login in to secure
 areas.
- Functionality Cookies which collect information such as your User ID, IP address and other settings to provide more personal features.
- Performance Cookies which do not collect personally identifiable information and are aggregated to collect information about the Service's performance because they collect statistical data about how visitors use our Service.
- Targeting Cookies which are used for targeting, advertising and measuring the effectiveness of an advertising campaign.

Third-party Cookies

In additional to our own cookies, we may also use third-party cookies to report usage statistics of the Service, deliver advertisements on and through the Service. Please note that our service providers, and/or our third-party advertisers and analytics partners may also use other standard technologies, such as web beacons, web bugs, clear gifs, local storage objects (such as HTML5 and Flash) and scripts. These help provide the functionality described in this policy.

What are your options regarding Cookies?

You can delete all cookies that are already on your computer and you can set most browsers to prevent them from being placed.
