

Precautions during fitment:

1. Avoid direct contact with sharp objects when removing the packaging.

Directions for use:

- 1. Have the bar placed on a rubber mat to avoid any damage during fitment
- 2. Ensure the bar is secure and not hindering the bumper of the vehicle before signing of the fitment.

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Fitment Instruction:

Visual / Graphic Illustration	Step#	Description/Method
Grill to be removed	1	Remove Grill - Remove the plastic clips securing the top of the grill. You must then slightly tilt the grill forward to unclip the bottom of the grill.
Air deflectors behind grill to be removed. (to be trimmed)	2	Remove the sump protector.
Sump protector to be removed	3	Remove the plastic covers from where the grill was located.
	4	Remove the anchors + remove plastic cover which is secured to the chassis with a big white plastic clip.

Visual / Graphic Illustration FIG 1 Drivers side shown.	5	On the chassis you will locate a hole and a raised section. Shown in FIG 1.
A F E Drivers side shown.	6	Assemble the drivers side brackets to the chassis. Shown in FIG 2. All brackets will have a D cut out to show the are for the drivers side. Do not fully tighten.
	7	Do the same to the passengers side of the vehicle. Do not fully tighten.

FIG 3	8	With both sides of the brackets mounted. You can now mount the nudge using the kit shown in FIG 3.
	9	Make sure the nudge is centered and aligned.
	10	Fully tighten all nuts and set screws to the correct torque.



Make sure bar is centralised and tighten all fasteners to specified torque. M8= 22Nm, M10= 42Nm, M6= 9Nm.
