

PROFESSIONAL PRODUCT USER GUIDE & INSTRUCTIONS

This User Guide will help you prepare for your upcoming bedbug treatment for an Emergency Response to an active infestation and will help to Prevent an active infestation.

The following list must be reviewed and implemented as directed prior to treatment. Doing so may increase the length of time to properly control OR eliminate the current infestation, Failure to comply with this list may also result in a decrease in the effectiveness of treatment.

CONSUMER INTEGRATED PEST MANAGEMENT PROGRAM
Preparation for Home Bed Bug Treatment —
Emergency Response & Prevent

- 1. KiltronX response is a measured layered perimeter control system that creates barriers with its fabric. Think of it as a barb-wired fence that once installed and comes in contact with a bedbug trying to breach the perimeter, and feed on you, your family and pets. It is therefore critical that you apply product as directed and thoroughly. It is a mechanical killer and not a poison. See "Science Behind KiltreX" in User Guide for more information.
- 2. Preparation and a successful treatment must include a thorough inspection for cracks, crevices and holes and particularly, nail holes, for all walls, window moldings, door frames and moldings, electrical outlets, floors, closets, plumbing, picture frames, computers, lamps, television sets, furniture, appliances, vents, HVAC, and anything that is attached to the walls; and also includes inspection of bedding and clothing. See KiltronX Graphics on where bed bugs hide and fabric should be installed (www.Kiltronx.us Home Page), These cracks, crevices and holes need to be blocked or sealed so that you create a bunker living space where bedbugs cannot enter the space from adjoining rooms/apartments or hide (as they are vampires and look for dark spaces) without coming into contact with KiltronX treated fabric in its various forms and applications. This inspection and the sealing of the cracks, crevices and holes, and/or the application of our KilTape to everything in your home where we know bed bugs frequent, hide, travel and colonize is critical to the prevention and control of bedbugs. There are no shortcuts. Once installed dead or living bedbugs may be found as they feed at different times and your installation may not have been thorough enough. Simply re-inspect where you installed and treated looking for any place you might have missed. KiltronX doesn't represent it is going to end the bed bug pandemic in America, but simply help control infestations and when diligently installed as instructed control and kill bed bugs.
- 3. Supplies required: water based painter's caulk, caulking gun, putty knife, scissors, measuring tape, Velcro, glue, light to heavy duty staple gun (T-20) and staples, double faced tape, KiltronX Quarantine Bags. Products Recommended for Proper Installation: Crackshot Spackle Paste by DAP or Liquid Nails® Projects Interior Construction Adhesive, for crevices, holes and cracks where bed bugs might hide (which all have to be filled); Scotch Indoor Mounting Tape with dispenser weight 2lbs.; Loctite Stik'N Seal Indoor Adhesive; 32 oz. spray bottle or larger; and ZEP spray head and bottle.
- 4. All items blocking access to the baseboard and carpet edges around the room need to be moved away from the wall, but NOT out of the infested room. Baseboards and carpet edges (the space between the tackless and the wall) provide an excellent harborage for bed bugs.
- 5. All contents of the dressers, nightstands and closets should be placed in green plastic treated quarantine bags (treated with KilSpray Activator after mixing with distilled water) with one (1) dozen KilPax or six (6) 6" pieces of KilTape and securely tied. Quarantine bag contents should remain in the bag for 48 hours, although, bedding and clothing that is needed can be removed in 4 (four) hours and then put through a dryer cycle as discussed below with KiltronX Dryer Strips and then returned to closets and beds only after the closets, beds and rooms have been treated. Treat the room first before putting anything back that has been treated. The idea is not to recontaminate after you have removed and treated your property and home. This should be done in the infested room to prevent spreading the bed bugs throughout the residence. All items that are "dryer safe" should be placed in the drver on medium heat for at least (40) forty minutes. If items are to be washed, then use sufficient detergent and set temperature as usual; hottest temperature not essential for water setting.

DO NOT PLACE APPLIANCES, ELECTRICAL ITEMS, COMPUTERS, CELL PHONES OR DIGITAL EQUIPMENT IN QUARANTINE BAG. THEY ARE TREATED WITH KILTAPE.

- Items that are dry clean only should be bagged as described above and brought to the dry cleaners. Dry cleaners should be notified of the infested items so the infestation does not spread within the facility.
- 7. All other items such as lamps, clocks, computers, radios, TV's, hanging pictures, etc. should be left in the infested room or residence for inspection and treatment. Not placed in quarantine bags. All of these items provide harborage for bed bugs and if not properly inspected can be a source of re-infestation.

- 8. Remove and bag all items on and under the bed prior to treatment. Once space is treated, items should be cleaned and treated before being placed back on and under the bed. This includes but not limited to storage boxes and shoes.
- DO NOT discard mattresses or furniture until inspection for bed bugs. Mattresses and furniture may not need to be discarded if treated properly. Mattress covers or encasements, other than KiltronX, should be removed from bed.
- 10. Although the ingredients in our KilSpray Activator are considered minimum risk and some of which can be found in a Wendy's Frosty beverage, considered non-allergenic, we ask to be notified of any allergies, chemical sensitivities, or similar medical conditions prior to treatment through email at info@kiltronx.us or phone 1-877-5-VAMPIRE. Children should not be present during an installation although they not need to be taken out of the home, but just the area you are treating.
- 11. Pets should be kept in other part of home while installation is taking place. Pet bedding must be sprayed and stuffed with KilPax stuffers and tape. Pets can be bathed with KilSpray Activator should you believe your dog or cat be infested. Do not spray into pet's face rinse pet thoroughly and dry.
- 12. The back of all furniture should be made accessible so that it can be treated with KilTape.

TIPS: It is extremely important not to remove any items from the infested residence before treatment. By doing this you increase the possibilities of spreading the bed bugs to other rooms or residences. Because bed bugs are excellent hitchhikers and they may enter the residence through a combination of various modes of transportation (automobiles, buses, trains, cruise ships, planes, trucks), family members and their pets, guests, supermarkets, movie theatres, shopping bags, luggage, furniture, clothing, boxes, backpacks, etc. when these items are moved between rooms, apartments, hotels, movie theatres, stores, homes and various modes of transportation. Furniture poses one of the greatest risk of harboring bed bugs and their eggs especially bed frames, headboards and mattresses, couches, chairs, ottomans and end tables. One should also think carefully about bringing in used or salvaged furniture into their homes. Once your living space has been prepared, your emergency response to a living infestation can begin with mixing and preparing our KilSpray Activator. It's easy as 1) spray; 2) apply KiltronX fabric in all its forms; and 3) spray again.

CIPM - PHASE II

Instructions for Home Bed Bug Treatment - Protection for Life

All KiltronX Fabric installation should be made seamless and does need to be visible to the human eye. Bedbugs are light sensitive varmints and are found in spaces and places where no light exists.

KiltronX is a nonvisible treatment. You, the owner, gets to determine and customize your own installation.

KiltreX with Cutelin Activator Powder and KilSpray Preparation:

See label for proper mixture of powder to water ratio. It is very important that the sprayer you use be thoroughly clean and

It is very important that the sprayer you use be thoroughly clean and that powder is mixed with distilled water. **KilTape:** Installation of KilTape can be made using any of the following fasteners: staples, glue, or double faced tape. You need to create a

fasteners: staples, glue, or double faced tape. You need to create a pocket so that the bedbugs can look to hide in between the inside of KilTape fabric and the surface that you are treating. This is accomplished by stapling and applying your fasteners every 7" to 10". There should be a space every 7" to 10" between fabric and surface to create the space pocket. KilTape cannot be sealed flush to surface but attached every 7" to 10". Note: All KiltronX Quarantine bags (green) do not come treated and need to be treated with KilSpray Activator — wait until spray dries — add treated fabric strips and place items in bags and shake bag. Let items remain in bag for 48-72 hours. Cloth and fabric items only in bags. Do not place electronics, appliances, computers and any type of hand held device into bags.

Preparation: After inspection and identifying areas that need to be sealed and treated begin by 1) spray; 2) install fabric; and 3) spray again. Never soak fabric. A nice misty spray works best. Spray will dry into a paste and should you need to clean any surface after spraying simply do so with a wet cloth and little to no pressure until clean.

Kitchen: Cabinets – Spray back of cabinets, install KilTape and lightly spray again. KilTape is installed to back of drawers, cabinets, tops of appliances, behind the stove, top of cabinets, kick plate bottoms of cabinet and also all sides of cabinets that are touching the wall must be taped. There can be no opening between the side of wall and cabinet. All crevices that are greater than a credit card in thickness need to be caulked and sealed. Treat with KilSpray Activator, then caulk and treat with KilSpray Activator again. Any cracks larger than the thickness of a credit card should be sprayed with KilSpray Activator, stuffed with KilPax or KilTape, treated with KilSpray Activator again. Bottoms and underneath counter top surface should be treated with 1) spray; 2) install fabric; and 3) spray again.

Bedroom(s):

Bedframe: Use KilTape. Spray area before installing KilTape, install KilTape and spray lightly again. Install leg booties. Include headboard and back of headboard, box spring (in and out) and taped. All moldings, cove base, window molding, all door moldings. Bottoms and underneath counter top surface should be treated with our 1) spray; 2) install fabric; and 3) spray again.

Mattress: Remove everything off mattress. If you suspect infestation spray mattress. Then install KiltronX mattress cover and spray top of cover and wait until dry. Then dress bed with bed clothing (which has been treated with either our dryer strips which includes everything from the bed skirt to pillow cases, comforters and any other type of bed clothing used). Bedframe must have leg booties (wrapping leg of bedframe with 1.5" KilTape). Box Spring top and bottom should also be sprayed and KilTape used. If there are any holes in the bottom or top of the box spring, the box spring should be sprayed on the inside and stuffed with KilPax and/or use KilTape.

Cribs: Special care should be given when dealing with a young baby child as they may choose to remove the KilTape or eat it. Install all KilTape and products out of the reach of baby/child.

Bathroom(s): Inspect for crevices, cracks and holes and sealing all with caulking. Must include all cold water and hot water drain line pipes found under the sink and behind toilets. Cabinets and hanging pictures also need to be treated with KilTape. Shelving, drawers, kitchen and — bathroom cabinets, underneath all tables and chairs -

1) spray; 2) install KilTape; and 3) spray again.

Closets: all closets must be treated. Inspect and seal closet for crevices, cracks and holes with caulking. Clothing removed completely. Clothing that is dryer safe first needs to be bagged in pretreated quarantine bag. Closet, once empty, must be taped which includes back of the closet shelves, top and bottom.

In the back of the closet, molding along the floor and molding around the door (keep KilTape inside the door). All hangers should be bagged with treated bags for 48 hours. All clothes that require dry cleaning should be taken to dry cleaners and not returned to closet until closet has been treated with tape. Tape, once installed, should be sprayed with activator to accelerate treatment.

Shoes: Put into plastic bags with dryer strips for 48-72 hours.

Furniture: Furniture is also 1) spray; 2) install KilTape; and 3) spray again. Legs of everything in room that touches floor must have leg booties installed. Reclining seats, sofa cushions, bottom of sofa, legs of sofa, back and insides of sofa, space between arms of cushion, under the cushions need to be treated with same system but use stuffers in areas where you cannot tape. Put liners under cushions. Turn over the couch and spray inside of couch and apply KilTape inside couch and upholstered chairs as well as the back of chair or couch. Cut KilTape and install, remembering to leave spacing between fasteners and KilTape.

Miscellaneous:

Ceiling Fans: Top of the fan should be inspected and any opening between wall and fan should be caulked and sealed. Do not spray electrical fixtures of any kind.

Window Treatments/Moldings: Moldings all the way around the window should be checked – top/sides – for crevices and then sprayed, sealed with caulking and sprayed again. No soaking. Window treatments should be removed and on top of window treatment and bottom of window treatment should be treated with 1.5" KilTape if possible.

If you are using any type of window treatment where the fixture allows for a space, example: venetian blind or mini blind, where the fixture has been installed. It must be treated by spraying, taped or stuffed and sprayed again. **Wall Vent Covers:** should be inspected for cracks and sealed. The covers should be removed and the inside should be taped where the cover meets the wall. **Wall thermostats:** Only if there is a space between the cover and the wall, should it be removed, taped and then put back on wall, but not sprayed. KilTape can be cut to size needed to accomplish the filling of any space. If the tape is too big, cut tape into smaller pieces and stuff it. Leg booties: Wrap legs with fabric and use double-faced tape or tapeto secure after wrapping leg with fabric.

Appliances: washers/dryers/microwaves/stoves, refrigerator, dishwasher, pulled out, inspected. Across the back and across top and bottom of appliance install a strip of KilTape. Walls should be sprayed and area under and directly behind appliances stuff and spray. Again, avoiding the spraying of any outlets or plugs.

KiltronX Quarantine Bags: You must treat Quarantine Bag with KilSpray Activator by spraying the inside of bag. Wait for bag to dry. Place KilTape strips inside bag. All clothing, bedding, curtains, and any type of fabric that is in the room must be quarantined by placing items in bag for 48 hours and following quarantine instructions on package. Run dryer safe clothing through dryer with dryer strips for 40 minutes at medium.

The quarantine KilTape can be put in dryer along with KiltronX dryer strips. Dryer Safe Bedding: run all through dryer with dryer strips. Dryer should be pre-treated with KiltreX Powder before using. Follow instructions on box or insert. Then load dryer directly from sealed Quarantined bags, adding KiltronX Dryer Strips. Dryer should be set to medium heat and allowed to run for 30 minutes.

Child Toys: Place toys into quarantine bag. Wipe toys down with warm water and reintroduce into room. Dispose of all rags into plastic bags and discard – do not re-use. We would recommend that various uses of our Applicator where fabric is placed into mesh, be used in children's rooms, closets and shelving.

Books/Magazines: Need to be pre-treat Quarantine bagged with KilStrips and sealed, lightly shaken and left in place for 72 hours. Remove books from Quarantine bag wipe with a dry rag. Make sure back of book shelves have been Kiltaped. Simply spray the back of the bookshelf then install Kiltape across the back face of the shelve and spray again. Then you will be ready to replace treated items.

Installation of KilTape: KilTape can be installed with a staple gun (T-20 recommended), glue, double-faced tape or Velcro. The key to the installation is providing for a minimum of 7"-10" between staples, 7"-10" between drops of glue or the use of Velcro or double-faced tape.

Under no circumstance are you to seal the tape to the surface without leaving spacing recommended. The distance below 7"-10" — the reason is that bedbugs will come in contact with fabric including hiding or passing through the inside space between the KilTape and the surface you are covering, coming into contact with the fabric and the powder it contains. When applying KilTape to furniture and chairs, run the tape along the perimeter of the back of the furniture or under the chair below the cushion. KilTape is to be used on the bottom and the back of all furniture and all types of tables. It is to be installed inside the back of kitchen cabinets — one strip — and on top of the kitchen cabinets if there is a space between ceiling and kitchen cabinet. For a better review please see illustrations below for graphics of those locations that require treatment with KiltronX products.

Applicators: Our applicators are to be used in furniture underneath cushions. Also used in storage boxes, luggage, backpacks, purses, all of which should be sprayed lightly if bedbugs are suspected.

KiltronX provides a layered perimeter wall that guards against bedbugs. KiltronX does not represent that it can in any way eliminate the bedbug problem in America but does provide you with an integrated pest management system for your home that will help control and help to eradicate and kill bedbugs from within your home. Once that is provided and your home is installed, it is our recommendation that you begin to use other KiltronX products to deal with travel, automobile, school, workplace, libraries, supermarkets and all other areas bedbugs are known travel, hide and hitchhike into the home.

Note: Must follow both Phase I of KiltronX's "Preparation for Home Bed Bug Treatment". The installation we are recommending must be followed diligently in order to deal with your emergency response bedbug infestation and/or prevention program. If you miss even one instruction, bedbugs may enter, colonize and reinfect your entire home.

Live Free Bed Treatment

1. Bed Clothing:

Remove all bedding and place into Live Free Quarantine Bag(s). Do not remove Quarantine Bag from room once filled without sealing Quarantine Bag closed. See Quarantine Bag(s) below.

2. Box Spring:

Remove box spring, leaving bedframe exposed. Once box spring has been sprayed and taped with KilTape as instructed it can be placed back into the bed frame.

Install KiltronX box spring wrap and/or box spring cover. Box spring wrap is pulled over top of box spring covering sides so that the bedbugs attempting to climb out come in contact with fabric and die. A combination of both the wrap and cover is recommended for maximum results. Lastly, spray surface of wrap and/or cover.

3. Box Spring Mattress:

Remove mattress. Inspect mattress for signs of bedbugs. Spray entire mattress – top, bottom and sides – with KilSpray. Once mattress has been treated as instructed place mattress back onto box spring and installs fitted Live Free Mattress Cover. Again, install mattress cover with soft side facing down onto mattress and the bonded printed side face up – pulling taut and stretching cover over all four corners of the mattress so that the fitter cover wraps underneath the mattress. KiltronX Live Free Mattress Cover is not an encasement and is designed for bedbugs to climb in and die.

See Cleaning Instructions to remove dead bedbugs found.

4. Bedframe:

Inspect entire bedframe for bedbugs — top and bottom. Spray all slats — wood or metal. Tape with KilTape. Spray all slats again. Special care should be made to runners where box spring is supported. All bedframe legs need to be wrapped with Leg Booties before box spring is put back into place (see Leg Booties below). The floor beneath the box spring should also be sprayed.

5. Headboard:

While you have just treated the bedframe it is now time to deal with the headboard. The back of headboard needs to be sprayed and taped with KilTape and then sprayed again. Affix KilTape around entire perimeter of back of headboard and spray again. KilTape should allow for a minimum of 7"-10" (pulled taut) between staples, glue or whatever method used to affix KilTape with.

6. Bed Clothing:

Place dryer safe bed clothing that has been placed in Containment Bags into dryer with Live Free Dryer Strips for a minimum of 20 minutes on medium heat. Special care should be taken when transferring bed clothing from Containment Bags to Dryer so that no bedbugs are released into laundry room. Dryer should be pretreated with KiltreX Powder before placing bed clothing.

Live Free Emergency Response Room Kit

Once Live Free Bed Treatment has been completed (see above) the Live Free Emergency Response Room Kit should be installed. See instructions below for KilTape, Leg Booties, Quarantine Bags, Dryer Strips, Activator Powder and Tool Kit.

In treating an emergency bedbug infestation you must spray area first, apply Live Free product and spray area again.

Live Free Mattress Cover

Once Live Free Bed Treatment has been completed (see above) the Live Free Fitted Mattress Cover can be installed. Install mattress cover with soft side facing down onto mattress and the bonded printed side face up — pulling taut and stretching cover over all four corners of the mattress so that the fitted cover wraps underneath the mattress. KiltronX Live Free Mattress Cover is not an encasement and is designed for bedbugs to climb in and die. See Cleaning Instructions to remove dead bedbugs found.

Live Free Prevention Room Perimeter Kit

See instructions below for KilTape, Leg Booties, Quarantine Bags, Dryer Strips, Activator Powder and Tool Kit.

Live Free Universal Furniture with Leg Bootie Kit

See instructions below for Cushion Liners and KilTape.

Live Free KiltreX with Cutelin Activator Powder Packet & Live Free KilSpray

Recommended you wear latex or rubber gloves and protective eyewear when working with KiltreX with Cutelin Activator Powder Packet and with KilSpray. Pour contents of Packet (see Powder to Distilled Water Ratio) into filter free spray apparatus and add distilled water.

Shake vigorously. Never soak fabric. A nice misty and uniform spray works best. Spray will dry into a paste and should you need to clean any surface after spraying simply do so with a wet cloth and little to no pressure until clean. Thoroughly clean sprayer between each use to avoid clogging. DO NOT over dilute.

POWDER TO DISTILLED WATER RATIO

1 oz. KiltreX with Cutelin Activator Powder Packet (makes 1 quart KilSpray) = add 1 oz. packet to a 1 quart capacity filter free spray apparatus and add 21 oz. of distilled water

filter free spray apparatus and add 31 oz. of distilled water.

Shake vigorously.

2 oz. KiltreX with Cutelin Activator Powder Packet

(makes 2 quarts KilSpray) = add 2 oz. packet to a 2 quart capacity filter free spray apparatus and add 62 oz. of distilled water. Shake vigorously.

4 oz. KiltreX with Cutelin Activator Powder Packet

(makes 1 gallon KilSpray) = add 4 oz. packet to a 1 gallon capacity filter free spray apparatus and add 124 oz. of distilled water. Shake vigorously.

8 oz. KiltreX with Cutelin Activator Powder Packet

(makes 2 gallon KilSpray) = add 8 oz. packet to a 2 gallon capacity filter free spray apparatus and add 248 oz. of distilled water. Shake vigorously.

16 oz. KilSpray Bottle = add ½ of a 1 oz. packet of KiltreX with Cutelin Activator Powder to bottle. Mix with 15½ oz. of distilled water. **32 oz. KilSpray Bottle =** add a 1 oz. packet of KiltreX with Cutelin Activator Powder to bottle. Mix with 31 oz. of distilled water. *Recommended for extended use/spraying use a one gallon (or greater) pump sprayer.*

KILSPRAY ACTIVE INGREDIENTS (% DRY WT.)

Soybean Oil (5%), for a total of 5% dry wt.

INERT INGREDIENTS: Proprietary process and mix of minimal risk inert ingredients consisting of calcium silicate, aluminum sodium silicate, iron oxide (Fe203), sodium sulfate, magnesium silicate, potassium sulfate, sodium benzoate, diatomaceousearth (<1% crystalline silica), amorphous silica, for a total of 95% dry wt.

TOTAL OF INERT AND ACTIVE INGREDIENTS IS:

100% dry wt. Mix with distilled water only. Mix well before spraying

Live Free Quarantine Bag(s)

Used for bedding, clothing, small items. Pretreat Quarantine Bag with Activator Spray on inside of bag. Add KilStrips and wait for inside of bag to dry. Place items inside bag(s). Seal bag let items remain in bag for 48-72 hours. When packing bag pack do not remove from area until bag has been filled and sealed. Do not place electronics, computers, mp3 players, cell phones, radios, appliances in bag.

Live Free KilPax Stuffing

The most versatile of products. Use to stuff crevices, gaps, furniture, bags, suitcases, molding, shipping, storage and anywhere a small piece of treated fabric is required. Push KilPax in place and they stay. Use in areas you cannot reach. In order to accelerate remediation process spray area first with Activator spray. Add KilPax. Spray again.

Live Free Universal KilTape Kit

KilTape can be installed with either a staple gun, glue, double-faced tape or Velcro or latex tube glue. The key to installation is providing for a minimum of 7" between staples, 7" between drops of glue or the use of Velcro or double-faced tape. Under no circumstance are you to close the distance below 7" — the reason is that bedbugs will hide inside the space between the KilTape and the surface you are covering, coming into contact with the fabric and the powder it contains. When applying KilTape to furniture and chairs, run the tape along the perimeter of the back of the furniture or under the chair below the cushion or inside furniture where and when possible.

KilTape is to be used on the bottomand the back of all furniture and all types of tables. It is to be installedinside against the back of all shelving and across the back of kitchen cabinets, back of appliances, inside of box springs where liner has beenripped, bed-frames, bed headboards, hanging picture frames, inside and cushions of reclining chair — cut and secure and on top of the kitchen cabinets if there is a space between ceiling and top, sides, or bottom of kitchen cabinet. Used to wrap and stuff any gap in plumbing, such as water lines, sewer lines, fresh water toilet lines that can be found below sinks and air conditioning lines.

Look for the gaps and simply wrap, stuff and fill with KilTape. $\label{eq:control} % \begin{center} \begin{ce$

For a better review please see illustrations below for all areas that need to be treated with KiltronX products.

Spray first install tape spray again — soft bottom down and bonded pattern on top. Closet molding facing inside of closet back of shelves. Can be adapted to be used almost anywhere needed to create secure barrier between bedbugs and you. Can go inside shoes, bags, any type of storage box, back of kitchen cabinets, area between carpet and wall.

See Phase I and Phase II for additional information.

Live Free Universal Cushion Liners

Place under cushions, reclining chairs and pillows. Can also be used on/in shelving. Can be used to sit on when traveling – i.e. movie theatre. Can be used in luggage, bags and in automobile – under and between seats. Place product with smooth surface face down and bonded print face up.

Live Free Applicators with Fabric

Use in closets, shelving, lockers and bags, school backpacks, totes, and here the idea is "don't bring them home". In case of an emergency response, spray the area you are protecting first, install applicator with fabric (lay applicator mesh side down). Upon infestation simply remove fabric insert, roll it up and vacuum Applicator. Place new fabric insert into Applicator and place back over area you are attempting to treat. Applicator is spot washable only.

Live Free Leg Booties

Wrap legs of all bedframes and legs of all furniture in home. Either double face tape, tape, Velcro or hot glue to hold fabric in place. Does not need to be visible to work. Can be installed/tucked high on legs. Place softer side on surface and bonded pattern on outside.

Live Free Bedbug Dryer Strips

It is recommended to pretreat dryer before using as bedbugs are known to colonize and hide on the bottom and back of dryer. Pretreat dryer with 2 tablespoons of Activator powder and spreading in dryer with 2 dryer strips. Run pretreatment through dryer – minimum 20 minutes. Repeat this treatment once per month or more if infestation is suspected in clothing or fabric you are drying.

Home Use:

Add to dryer 1 to 3 dryer strips per load of laundry.

Sold for convenience and speed in dealing with Response to Emergency bedbug infestation to get you started. A T20 stapler and staples is also recommended for use where appropriate on KilTape.

Live Free Foundation Wrap, Mattress Wrap, Box Spring Wrap

KiltronX box spring wrap and/or box spring cover is pulled over top of box spring covering sides so that the bedbugs attempting to climb out come in contact with treated fabric and die. A combination of both the wrap and cover is recommended for maximum results.

Lastly, spray surface of wrap and/or cover.

Live Free KilSpray Travelers Kit

See instructions for Luggage Applicator, Quarantine Bag(s) and KiltreX with Cutelin Activator Powder. Emergency Response and Quarantine Bag. In case of suspected bedbug infestation immediately empty contents of luggage into Quarantine Bag and seal Quarantine Bag. Inspect your Applicator for infestation.

If infestation has occurred remove insertwith dead bedbugs from Applicator, rolling up the fabric and placing itinto a sealed container for recycling and inspection. Reinsert replacementtreated fabric insert into Applicator and place face down in luggage.

Place clothing in sealed Quarantine Bag back into luggage to transport home. If dryer is available put whatever clothing is dryer safe into the dryer after you have pretreated dryer with Activator powder and set dryer at medium heat for 20 minutes with 3 dryer strips per load. Remove clothing that has been treated through the dryer, fold and place back into luggage. You will repeat this same process once you return home before reintroducing contents of luggage into home.

Before packing luggage, place Applicator with insert mesh side down in bottom of luggage/bag using appropriate size Applicator for piece of luggage/bag. Place clothing into luggage/bag.
