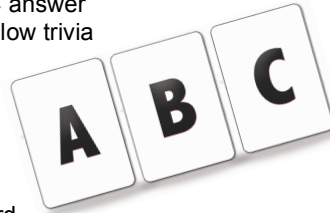

## SET UP

Choose a person to keep score and distribute one set of the white ABC answer cards to each player. Place the yellow trivia cards face down in a pile.



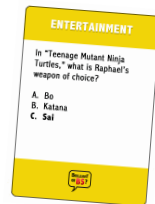
## GUESSING

Picking from the top of the pile, one person reads aloud a trivia card and the three multiple choice answers. This person is the first Judge. Hold the trivia card so that no one can see the answers.

The other players have 10 seconds to respond by placing one of their ABC answer cards face down, keeping the letter they chose hidden from the other players.

Starting with the player to the Judge's left and going clockwise, each player tries to convince the Judge that they chose the correct answer.

Without saying any of the multiple choice answers or hinting at them, players must explain how or why they know the correct answer. If you don't know it, **FAKE IT!** The Judge may interrogate the other players if necessary and trash talking is always encouraged.



## JUDGING

After everyone pleads their case, the Judge gives the Brilliant Card to one person they think chose the right answer and the BS Card to one person they think chose the wrong answer. If you're one of the players answering the question, your goal is to persuade the Judge to give you the Brilliant card!

If you're the Judge, your goal is to figure out which player actually knows the answer and who's just BSing. There's only one of each card so the Judge better be sure!

The player that receives the Brilliant Card automatically earns 2 points and the player who receives the BS Card earns 0 points.

## THE BIG REVEAL

The Judge announces the correct answer (highlighted in bold) before asking the other players to reveal their answers.



The players who did NOT receive a Brilliant or BS Card go first, followed by the player who received the BS Card.

In dramatic fashion, the person who received the Brilliant Card reveals their answer last. Each player that chose the correct answer earns 1 point.

The Judge receives 1 point for a correct Brilliant prediction and 1 point for a correct BS prediction. But beware! For each wrong prediction, the Judge loses 1 point.

Once all points are tallied, the player to the Judge's left is the new Judge and reads a different trivia card to kick off the next round.

Play continues until each player has had the chance to be the Judge twice. The player with the most points at the end of the game wins.



## WHAT IF?

As the Judge, what happens if you think everyone chose the right answer? Give the Brilliant Card to one player of your choice and hold on to the BS Card. If everyone answers correctly, you earn 2 points. But if even one person chose the wrong answer, you lose 2 points.

Same rules apply if you think everyone chose the wrong answer. Give the BS Card to one player and hold on to the Brilliant Card. If everyone chose the wrong answer, you earn 2 points. But if even one person chose the correct answer, you lose 2 points.

If a player says any of the answers or drops a hint during their explanation, that player loses 1 point and is disqualified for that round only.

## TIEBREAKER

If two or more players have the same score after the final question, you can agree to shake hands and call it a draw OR those players can compete in a trivia showdown. Players take turns reading a single question to each other. One point is awarded for each correct answer until the tie is broken and someone wins.

## SCOREKEEPING

Announce points after each round. If you need help keeping track of the score, download a scorecard/cheat sheet from the FAQ page of BrilliantOrBS.com
