Notes for parents and other adult readers

Sitting down to read a book with a young child is a special privilege, and helping them take early steps in getting to know their world, themselves and God is even more special. However this book is not just intended to be read, but to be a springboard for helping children learn throughout the day (Deuteronomy 6:4-7; Psalm 145:3-7). Here are a few tips to help you adapt your reading and help their learning go beyond these pages:

For really little ones: This is a simple introduction for little ones and there is a lot that isn't said (including concepts like forgiveness). But it's a first step to know that God always sees us, because children (like adults!) try to cover up, shift blame, and pretend to be innocent. But they can't deceive God. Hopefully this book will lay foundations for little ones to learn (as they grow) about confession and repentance, as well as show them how much we need God's forgiveness.

For bigger ones: The word 'sin' is not used in this book, rather some specific sins that most young children can identify with (and so see that they do things they shouldn't do). The aim of this book is partly to help children recognize sin. You can then help your child to see that these things are called 'sin'. We also want them to learn that we don't just say sorry to a person we have wronged, but also to God (whom we have ultimately sinned against). All of this prepares them for understanding that God takes our sin so seriously that he sent Jesus to take the punishment we deserve.

Other Bible passages to look at: Psalm 32:5; Psalm 69:5; 1 John 1:8-9.

Pray: Parts of this book can be prayed as a useful model for confessing sin (which is important for children to both learn about and do).
