


Transform your Bible understanding


The message of Mark's Gospel Jeremy Duff

Do you know who wrote Mark's Gospel?


Jeremy Duff provides insightful answers in his book Peter's Preaching, revealing how an ancient source describes Mark as Peter's translator to a Greek-speaking world. Intriguingly, though, this source also tells us that while Mark recorded Peter's preaching 'accurately', he did not record it 'in order'. Mark devised his own order of the stories, for his own purpose, using a structure and format that were as radical in the first century as ebooks are today.

But that is only the start of Jeremy's detective work in this stimulating book, which moves on to uncover Peter's thoughts on the key themes of the Christian message, found distributed throughout the Gospel. Jeremy pieces these themes together like a jigsaw to reveal how Peter understood them, and how that understanding helps us to appreciate the radical nature of first-century Christian faith.





Spiritual formation in the hard places of life



Popular author and retreat leader **Tony Horsfall** turns his attention in Deep Calls to Deep to the raw pain and honesty of suffering found in the Psalms of Lament, psalms that show the psalmist daring to be real and straight with God.

These 'sad songs' make up nearly a third of all the psalms and yet they are mostly neglected by the church today. Much of our spirituality is geared toward relieving our pain and finding ways to ensure happiness, success and well-being. Anything that contradicts this rosy picture of cheerful certainty is ignored, denied or avoided. Yet struggle and challenge are necessary for authentic spiritual growth. The reality is that God sometimes does lead us down difficult paths as he seeks to draw us closer to himself and form his life within us Far from being an invalid expression of the Christian life, suffering may well be an inescapable part of the journey of knowing God more intimately.
