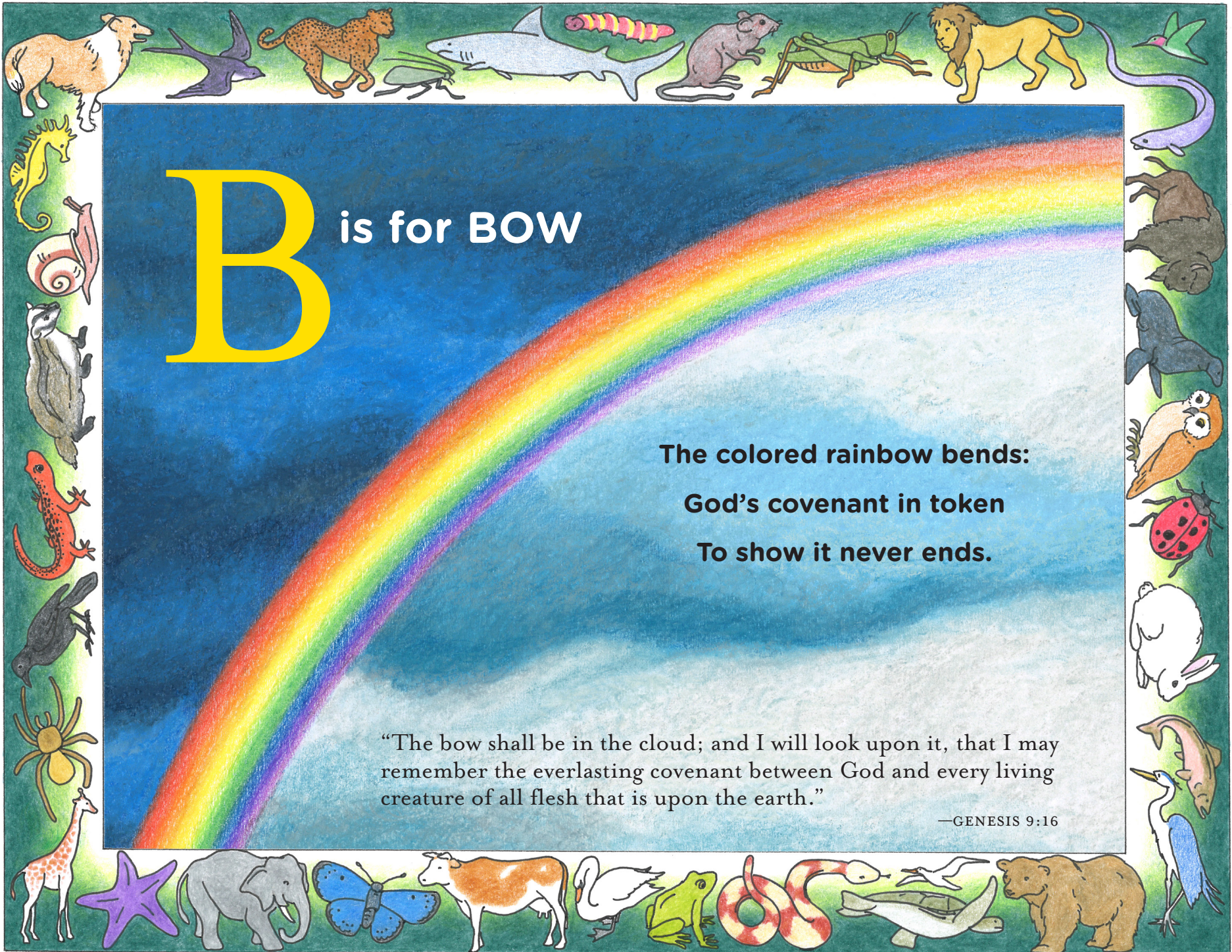


A is for ANTS
