



## Morning Studio Watercolor Classes at the Botanical Gardens

Taught by Joan Saba, Artist

Studio classes are for students confident in their artistic ability. Students bring paintings in progress for advised instruction and feedback.

Class meets on select Monday mornings from 8:45-10:45AM. Locations of the class vary depending on availability. Look for posted signage in front of the administration building when you arrive. Attendance will be taken at each class. Pre-registration is required.

Class Series and Dates for Fall 2018:

- Series IM1 – September 10, 17, 24, October 1
- Series IM2 – October 15, 22, 29, November 5
- Series IM3 – November 12, 26, December 3, 10

Suggested class supplies:

- 12" X 16" board (Clipboard, thick cardboard, homosote or Masonite)
- Choose 'artist's grade' tube paint. Winsor & Newton is recommended, however, select the best you can afford, or bring what you already have. Suggested colors include the following:
  - Permanent Rose
  - Winsor Red or Cadmium Red
  - New Gamboge
  - Winsor Yellow or Lemon Yellow
  - French Ultramarine
  - Winsor Blue (Green shade) or Cobalt Blue
  - Viridian
  - Winsor Violet
  - Burnt Sienna
  - Burnt Umber
- Palette: white plastic with deep wells and large mixing area
- Paper: 140# cold-pressed. Good brands include Arches, Fabriano, Strathmore, etc.
- Pencil
- Kneaded eraser
- Paper towels
- Water container
- White artist's tape
- Brushes: Synthetic or sable- These sizes are only a suggestion. Choose what looks and feels good to you.
  - Flats 3/8 & 3/4
  - Rounds # 0, 2, 6, 10
