



FREE CROSSHATCH BRUSH for PHOTOSHOP



Loading Brushes into Photoshop

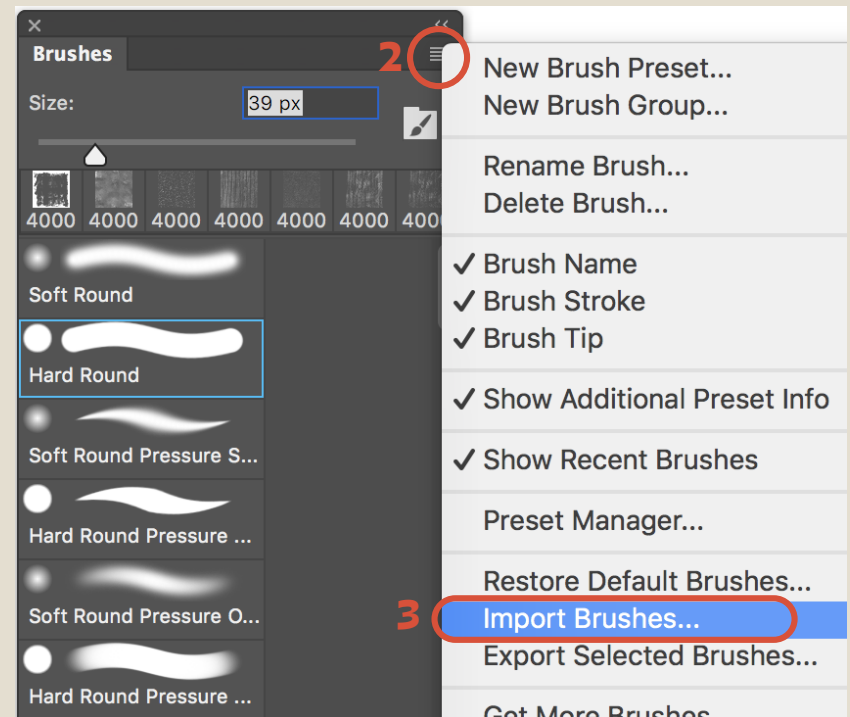
OPTION 1 (the easy way) - Just double click on the .abr (brush preset) file to load the brushes into Photoshop.

OPTION 2 (the organized way) - Drop your .abr file into your Photoshop Brushes folder:


Mac: Applications > Photoshop > Presets > Brushes

Windows: Program Files > Adobe > Photoshop > Presets > Brushes

- 1) Navigate to your brushes window (Window > Brushes)
- 2) Click on the tab at the top right of the brushes window
- 3) Select Import Brushes... (or Load Brushes...) and navigate to the .abr file.



Using Brushes in Photoshop

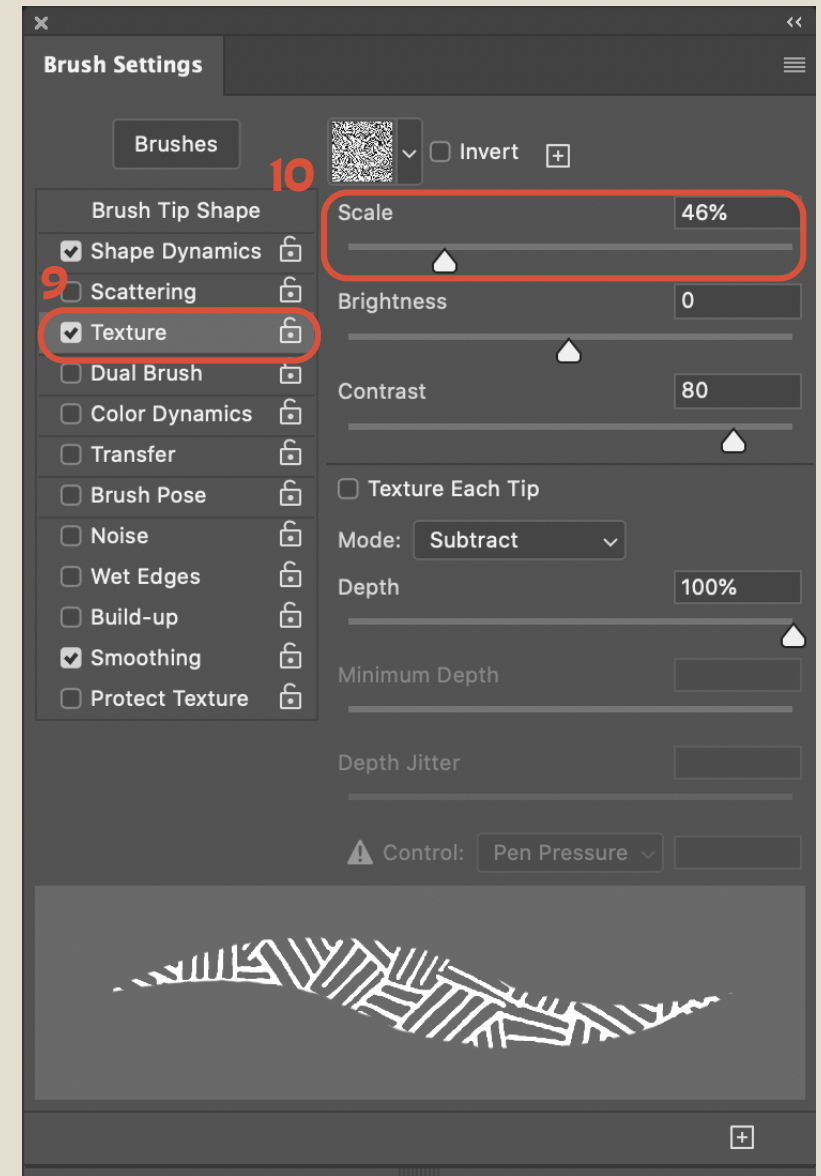
- 4) Open or create a new Photoshop file.
- 5) Highlight your Paintbrush tool in  toolbar.
- 6) Navigate to your **Brushes window in Photoshop** (Window > Brushes) to select a brush.
- 7) You can size your brush with the left & right bracket keys [] - make sure caps lock is turned off so you can see the brush cursor size.

SCALING THE TEXTURE PATTERNS

8) The main modification you will want to make is to **scale the size of your texture pattern** up or down. You can do this by navigating to the **Brush Settings Window** (Window > Brush Settings).

9) Highlight the “Texture” option.

10) Adjust the “Scale” slider to change the scale of the Crosshatch texture.
