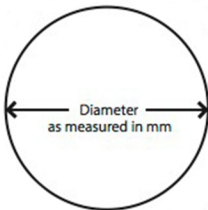
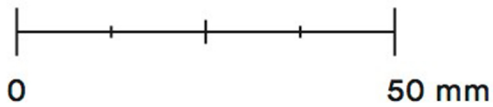
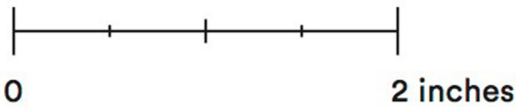




## RING SIZING GUIDE

- *Finding Your Size* -

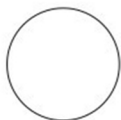
1. **Print this page.** Set page scaling to 100% or "Actual size" on a U.S. sized paper (8.5" x 11").
2. **Scale Match?** You will know the print is sized correctly when the scale on the left measures 2 inches.

3. **Use one of your own rings to measure.** Match a simple round ring to one of the circles below. The ring you use to measure should be a plain band that easily comes on and off to ensure accuracy.

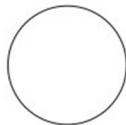
\* Please note: A ring with stones or shaped differently may result in an inaccurate measurement.

4. **Match your ring!** Place your ring over the circles below and match it to the nearest size, to the inside edge of your ring.

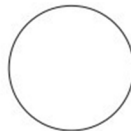
5. **In between sizes?** If you are in between sizes, make sure to order the larger size. If you are looking at a ring with a wider band, you may need to size up one size.



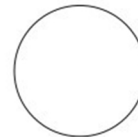

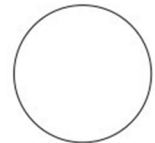
**Size 5**

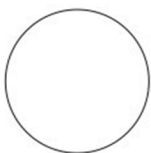

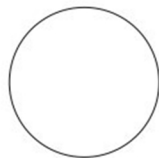
