The Chelsea Trunk Bag gets so many things right. It won't flop over when not fully stuffed. It has only the pockets you need—including a padded tablet sleeve, a water bottle pouch, and a waterproof exterior zipper pocket. Four hook-and-loop attachments make installing and removing the bag to the rear rack a snap, and a long, adjustable strap transforms it into an over-the-shoulder bag for day trips. It's super sturdy and made with water-resistant fabric (which is also available in Black Herringbone). For every 50 Po Campo bags sold, the company donates a bike to a child in Africa who needs one.

STAN'S DART

The DART is the fastest and easiest tubeless plug we've used, and also the most effective. The chemically treated "feathers" interact with the latex in your tubeless sealant to essentially replace the rubber in the tire's casing. We're still riding tires with DART plugs months after installing them.

82 | BURLEY KAZOO

Balance bikes are incredible teaching tools for little riders, but sometimes you just want to go *faaaarr*. To put in more miles (and teach the mechanics of pedaling), hook up Burley's Kazoo trail-a-bike. It's solidly made, feels stable, attaches easily, and puts kids in a comfortable position that lets them pedal as much as they want, or just hang on and chill as you power up Alpe d'Hometown, or whatever you call that monster hill, on your next family excursion.
