We are working to expand our programs to Indigenous communities throughout Latin America, increasing our reach from 750 women to more than 1,000.

Since our first virtual event – *¡Fiesta! 2020: Giving Back Together* – we have hosted more than a dozen successful events, including our Fashion Forward Gala: Celebrating Our 15th Anniversary! In partnership with Mercado Global partner artisans, we design and produce fashion accessories and now – masks – for boutiques and major retailers including Nordstrom, Bloomingdale's, Levi's®, Free People, and Stitch Fix.

From our first feature on the cover of Newsweek sixteen years ago, we've continued receiving major press coverage across the Americas. Since our pivot in March 2020 to producing and donating masks, we've received **nearly 20 media placements** and generated more than **6M media impressions**.
