



YARN TWISTERS

Chunky Textured Cowl

created by Lisa Overby



Great second knitting project to follow the Easy Basketweave Buttoned Cowl. Learn to knit in the round while knitting this chunky textured cowl. Cowl can be wrapped around neck twice or pulled down over shoulders.



MATERIALS & INFO

Yarn: 3 balls Drops Andes, 90m (98yards)/ball or approx. 270m (294 yard)
chunky weight yarn

Gauge: 9sts x 16 rows in stitch pattern

Needles: 9mm (US13) 32” circular needle

Notions: stitch marker, darning needle

Finished size: 33cm (13”) tall, 133cm (52”) around

ABBREVIATIONS

BO – Bind off

CO – Cast on

K – Knit

P – Purl



PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Using the long tail cast on method, cast on 128 stitches, join to knit in the round. Place marker to denote the beginning of the round.

Rows 1 & 2 – *P7, K1*, repeat * to *

Rows 3 & 4 – K1, *P5, K3*, repeat * to * until 2 sts remaining, K2

Rows 5 & 6 – K2, *P3, K5*, repeat * to * until 3 sts remaining, K3

Rows 7 & 8 – K3, *P1, K7*, repeat * to * until 4 sts remaining, K4

Rows 9 & 10 – Repeat Row 5 & 6

Rows 11 & 12 – Repeat Row 3 & 4

Repeat Rows 1 to 12 3 more times (total of 4 repeats), then repeat rows 1 & 2 once.

Bind off loosely, weave in ends and block.
