PulseWorx Gateway

The Gateway is for all UPB gear

Did you know that while the official name of the Gateway is the "PulseWorx Gateway" it can control all PulseWorx UPB devices as well as all UPB devices from all UPB device manufacturers as well?

Just as UPStart can configure any option in any UPB device from any manufacturer, the Gateway can also control any UPB device.

For example, if you have switches from Simply Automated or HAI/Leviton in your UPStart file, when the file is exported to the Gateway all those devices appear on the mobile display and you can use both short and long taps on them just like PulseWorx devices.

If your home has a mix of devices from different manufactures – perhaps to get a needed device that is only available from a single manufacturer – just export your UPB file to the Gateway as usual and then you are ready to go.

Here are some points to be aware of:

The Simply Automated switch bodies that have swappable faceplates – to give you more rockers or buttons then needed to control the load load(s) - are not treated with the same "popup" keypad mechanism used for the PulseWorx keypads.

The Simply Automated devices that control multiple loads are fully supported in that each load receives its own icon on the mobile application display. This is the same way that the PulseWorx OCM is supported.

The Simply Automated 3-input, 2-output is fully supported and you can select which inputs and/or outputs appear on the mobile application display.

The bottom line is that regardless of the UPB devices in your home, the PulseWorx Gateway can keep track of their state and can control them all.
