Instructions

The vial pendant used in this necklace has been filled with water. Simply fill up your vial with water after placing in your seahorse charm.

1. Begin by cutting 2.5 feet of chain using your flush cutters and set it aside for now.
2. Open the vial. Fill it almost halfway with the mix of blue seed beads.
3. Drop in the seahorse charm.
4. Fill the vial with water, and firmly seal shut. For additional security, place a dab of E6000 around the inside of the cap when you seal it. Allow it to dry for

at least 20 minutes.

5. Using your chain nose pliers, open up the antiqued brass jump ring and attach one end of your chain length to it. Also attach the vial to the same jump ring, and close.
6. Attach one jump ring to the other end of your chain length and also attach your lobster claw. Close the jump ring.
7. You're all set!
