











How to Right Angle Weave (RAW)

			
<p>1 Place 4 beads onto your thread. Leave a tail of 8 inches.</p>	<p>2 Loop around and tie a surgeons knot.</p>	<p>3 Pass back through 3 beads.</p>	<p>4 Pick up 3 more beads and pass back through 1 bead.</p>
			<p>Repeat steps 4-7 to create length.</p> <p>If you have an even number of units, proceed to step 8.</p> <p>If you have an odd number of units, flip your beadwork upside-down and proceed to step 8.</p>
<p>5 Pass up through 2 more beads.</p>	<p>6 Pick up 3 more beads and pass back through 1 bead.</p>	<p>7 Pass back through 2 more beads.</p>	
<p>Follow next 3 steps to complete the second row.</p>			
	<p>8 Work thread back through 3 beads, pick up 3 beads and go back through 1 more to make the 1st unit of the 2nd row.</p>	<p>9 Pass through 1 bead, pick up 2 more and pass through 2 to make the 2nd unit.</p>	<p>10 Pass through 3 beads, pick up 2 more beads. Repeat steps 9-10 to finish the 2nd row.</p>

Stopper Bead



Place a stopper bead 12 inches from your thread tail. Place a bead on thread and loop back through it. Pull.
