Lail Vineyards 2014 Cabernet Sauvignon Retail - \$85.00

90% Cabernet Sauvignon 10% Petit Verdot from Napa Valley. Winemaker Philippe Melka states "Blueprint Cabernet Sauvignon 2014 is refined, seductive and muscular, with a nose that is very expressive with dark notes of blackberry, blueberry, white chocolate and black cherry. In the mouth it is juicy, vibrant and fresh. There is a lot of tension in this beauty, with the Blueprint cabernet Sauvignon's signature delicious and elegant texture tied to pure flavors of bittersweet chocolate, spice and caramel. Decant it if possible in its youth to allow the complexity and opulence to shine through"

Salvestrin 2013 Estate Cabernet Sauvignon Retail - \$ 65.00

90% Cabernet Sauvignon, 7% Merlot and 3% Cabernet Franc. The Salvestrin Cabernet comes from their estate in St. Helena, Dr. Crane Vineyard. Despite low rainfall, excellent growing conditions occurred in 2013 yielding one of the finest Salvestrin Estate Cabernets in recent years. The nose shows layered aromas of blackberry preserves, cassis, and barrel spices. On the palate a rich texture and tremendous depth of ripe dark fruit flavors are unveiled. Tannins are apparent yet integrated and build, to frame a finish that is long and ripe. While this is a powerful Cabernet it maintains traditional Salvestrin elegance and polish.

Brainchild 2013 Red Blend Retail - \$ 40.00
