Familiar Air 2016 Cabernet Sauvignon Napa Valley Retail - \$115

We loved this Cabernet & wanted to share it with you from the moment we tasted it.

Familiar Air is a culmination of over ten years of friendship between Kimberly Jones and Benoit Touquette. They sourced the best vineyards in Napa Valley to produce this extremely limited bottling.

Composition: 95% Cabernet Sauvignon (Calistoga/Saint Helena) 5% Merlot Oakville

Production: 168 cases

Winemaker: Benoit Touquette

Touquette was mentored under Michel Rolland and has consulted for Screaming Eagle, Ovid & Arietta. Benoit is the winemaker for Realm Cellars, Kata and Hartwell.

Goldeneye Pinot Noir Ten Degrees Retail - \$125

We have loved this wine for years and the 2014 is the best of them.

The name "Ten Degrees" comes from Goldeneye's four estate vineyards that only span eight miles but vary as much as 10 degrees!

The pinnacle of Goldeneye's portfolio, Ten Degrees showcases their four estate vineyards to express the beauty and elegance of Anderson Valley Pinot Noir. Highlighting the lush texture of our Confluence Vineyard, the richness and opulent dark fruit of Gowan Creek, the structure and intensity of Split Rail, and the wild, rustic character of The Narrows, Ten Degrees is an impeccably balanced and age-worthy wine that reveals itself in complex layers. Notes of leather, spice, currant and blueberry glide across the silky palate, finishing with a hint of pennyroyal and a kiss of toasty oak.

Composition: 100% Pinot Noir

Cooperage: 100% French Oak

Barrel Aging: 16 months
