Laurel Glen 2016 Estate Cabernet Sauvignon Retail - \$110

Bettina Sichel is steward of Laurel Glen and is fifth generation of the Sichel family to work in the industry. Sichel has over 30 years wine industry experience, including helping launch Quintessa. As steward of the land Laurel Glen is certified organic. Phil Coturri is the vineyard manager and farms without synthetic fertilizers, fungicides, herbicides, or pesticides.

Accalades: Based on 100% Cabernet Sauvignon from the estate vineyard in the Sonoma Mountain AVA, the 2016 Cabernet Sauvignon Laurel Glen Vineyard was brought up in 55% new French oak. It sports a deep purple color as well as lots of mineral-drenched black and blue fruits along with notes of charcoal, graphite, and lead pencil. It's rich and medium-bodied, with beautiful purity of fruit and a balanced style that's going to age gracefully. It shows the purity, balance, and overall harmony of this great vintage. 94 Points - Jeb Dunnuck
