DESCRIPTION

Optimally cleanable, extra matt wall paint based on a special binding agent combination. The dry paint coating is moisture-repellent to reduce dirt build-up and remains permanently matt after cleaning. Highly suitable for use on walls in public buildings and rooms that are prone to dirt/dust accumulation such as kitchens, bathrooms and entrance halls. For interior use

RECOMMENDED USE

As a durable and very easily cleanable, even matt finish for interior walls and ceilings. Suitable surfaces include: existing coats of wall paint, cement and plasterwork, concrete. brick, gypsum panelling, etc. Also extremely suitable for painting glass fibre fabric.

RECOMMENDED SYSTEM

General information: The surface must be capable of supporting the paint, completely set, clean, dry, and free from dust or grease. Repair cracks and fissures. Remove and/or repair all loose and unstable coats.

New, untreated substrates

- Prime highly absorbent surfaces in their entirety using Stabilising primer.
- Thoroughly clean powdery surfaces. Prime with Stabilising primer after allowing to dry.
- After drying, apply 2 coats of Ultra Clean.

Existing intact coats of wall paint

- Clean using Paint cleaner.
- Apply an intermediate coat of Wall Primer Extra Opaque if necessary.
- After drying, apply 2 coats of Ultra Clean.

Existing, flaking coats of wall paint

- Remove loose parts.
- Thoroughly wash powdery coats and allow them to dry.
- Carry out any repairs.
- Prime with Stabilising primer.
- After drying, apply 2 coats of Ultra Clean.

Contamination caused by nicotine, damp, rust or soot

- Clean thoroughly using Paint cleaner.
- Treat surface/stain with Sealing primer.
- After drying, apply 2 coats of Ultra Clean.

SURFACE PREPARATION

The surface must be capable of supporting the paint, completely set, clean, dry, and free from dust or grease. Repair cracks and fissures. Remove and/or repair all loose and unstable coats.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Stir thoroughly prior to use. The first coat can be diluted with a maximum of 5% water. Apply in 1 or 2 coats using a suitable brush, paint roller or paint sprayer. For optimal cleanability, apply 2 coats. To avoid visible marks, always work wet-on-wet and distribute the paint evenly. Back-roll all overlaps in the same direction. Do not touch up when drying. Very easy to touch up after drying.
