## breakfast and brunch

<u>Terra Bagel</u> - Fresh bagels made daily with locally sourced ingredients – it doesn't get much better. Pair one of their delicious bagel sandwiches with a house brewed coffee and you'll be starting your day off on the right foot.

Wealthy Street Bakery - How does a blueberry muffin and coffee sound? Wealthy Street Bakery has a wide variety of baked goods (the Island Cookie is a favorite) and coffee menu. You can also try their selection of sandwiches or pizza for lunch & dinner.

<u>Cherie Inn</u> - This European style café is perfect for breakfast or lunch. You can't go wrong with the cinnamon french toast or the Lake Drive omelet for breakfast at this adorable café. They also have a great selection of salads or sandwiches for lunch.

Brown Butter Creperie and Café - If you love crepes, you'll love Brown Butter Creperie and Café. This cute café has sweet crepes, savory crepes and Belgian waffles that are delicious for breakfast or afternoon snack

<u>Terra</u> - Terra offers a unique, farm-to-table brunch with both sweet and savory dishes. Not one of them has been a disappointment.

**Donkey** - If you're craving tacos, make your way to Donkey. Donkey has the best tacos, guacamole and margaritas in Grand Rapids.

The Gerald Ford Presidential Museum - Presidential museum and burial place of Gerald Ford, the 38th president of the United States.

<u>Grand Rapids Children's Museum</u> - Hands-on learning space for kids ages 2-10 features a real beehive & workshops like robot building.

<u>Frederik Meijer Gardens & Sculpture Park</u> - 158acre botanical garden, art museum, and outdoor sculpture park.

## places to stay

The Leonard at Logan - The Leonard at Logan House is a Grand Rapids bed and breakfast in a historic neighborhood providing a quaint alternative to hotel lodging. ## top picks downtown

<u>House of Wine</u> - If you enjoy wine, head to House of Wine. You'll find a wide variety of wine and wine flights to enjoy with a charcuterie board or sandwich.

Mertens Prime - If you love French cuisine you'll love Mertens Prime. This French steakhouse and bistro has amazing food and drinks. You can also visit Café Mertens for poutine, beignets or coffee.

Reserve - You can't go wrong with dinner or drinks at Reserve. You'll find an extensive wine list, great cocktails, amazing charcuterie plates, and delicious dinner options. The house made pasta is really good.

**Knoop** - Located on the top floor of the Canopy by Hilton Hotel downtown, you'll find Knoop. This rooftop beer garden has Dutch and German inspired bites (don't miss out on the pretzels) along with craft cocktails.

<u>Bistro Bella Vita</u> - Bistro Bella Vita has modern French and Italian cuisine downtown Grand Rapids. You'll find great pizzas, pasta dishes and more here.

<u>Luna</u> - Hip, modern Mexican restaurant serving tacos and creative cocktails in a dark, stylish space. One of the best margaritas in GR.

<u>Butcher's Union</u> - Whenever I have dinner at Butcher's Union I feel like I'm back in Chicago. This restaurant has a great vibe and delicious food and drinks. The salmon is my go-to for dinner.

<u>Cakabakery</u> - Whenever I'm craving a sweet treat I head to Cakabakery. Their chocolate chunk cookies are the absolute best – trust me.

<u>Lumber Baron Bar</u> - Nestled in the Amway Grand Plaza Hotel downtown, Lumber Baron is a cozy, warm and intimate cocktail lounge that is perfect for a nightcap.
