

#### "The Lovejoy" Leather Drawer Pull △ 503.447.6889 **Installation Instructions**

- Gather your tools: drill, screwdriver, ruler, pencil.
- On the reverse side of this paper is the installation template. Fold the paper template at FOLD LINE. Measure to make sure the template is where you want it horizontally.
- Mark the center of the 3 crosshairs with a pencil.
- Drill a pilot hole using a 3/32" drill bit right where you made your 3 marks. Optionally, make only the top pilot hole larger by using a 7/32" drill bit.
- Screw the two small Philips head screws into place.
- Insert the provided Chicago-screw (surfaceless head) through the leather and into the hole you drilled in the door/drawer face. You will need to bend the leather into place, creating the concave grip.
- The hardware provided includes a few back screws of different lengths for doors and drawers of differing thicknesses. Choose the back-screw that fits your project the best. Secure the pull by tightening the chosen back screw into the Chicagoscrew on the backside of the door/drawer. Nicely done!
