
## SNOWDRIFT

table runner 12 1/2" x 20 1/2" by Kathy Schmitz

## SUPPLIES:

·ivory colored Felted Wool 26"  $\times$  26" or 1/2 yard approximately 25"  $\times$  32" \*\*\*You will need enough for one piece 14"  $\times$  22" and additional wool for the circles - 11 - 4" circles, 11 - 2 1/2" circles, and 19 - 1 1/2" circles

To felt wool, wash in hot water and dry on high. There are helpful tutorials on YouTube.



This diagram is to explain the amount of wool that is needed. The templates and cutting instructions will be provided on my blog on July 13, 2020

\*the sample was stitched using ivory colored wool but this would also be pretty using a wintery blue and ecru thread. YouTube has many helpful tutorials on how to felt wool yardage.

- · Valdani 12wt pearl cotton Wheat Husk O 514 1 ball
- ·Sulky 12wt thread deep ecru petite spool 50yd
- \*This thread is used to whip stitch the circles in place. Any heavy thread that matches the wool color will work well.
- ·1/2" buttons with 4 holes 11 ivory colored
- ·ivory seed beads around 100
- $\cdot$ ecru chenille yarn for trim 2 yd
- ·freezer paper to cut circle templates
