



HOW TO DETERMINE YOUR RING SIZE

Not sure your ring size? We're here to help. Our team created this guide to help but ideally we recommend visiting our storefront, your favorite local jeweler and getting sized in person. Many of our rings are easily resized but there are some that cannot (for example, most rings with stones or patterns all around). BEFORE MEASURING – CONFIRM PRINTED PAPER SIZE

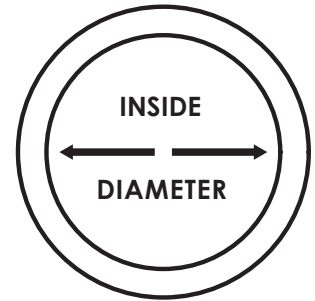

1. Ring measurements are very exact. Precisely follow these instructions to obtain an accurate measurement.
2. Before printing, make sure the Page Scaling is set to "None" on your print dialog box.
3. Measure the bar on the left. It must be exactly **1 inch** or **30 mm** long. Alternately, place a quarter where indicated. The quarter should fit completely over the image so that all lines are covered, without the quarter hanging over any edges.

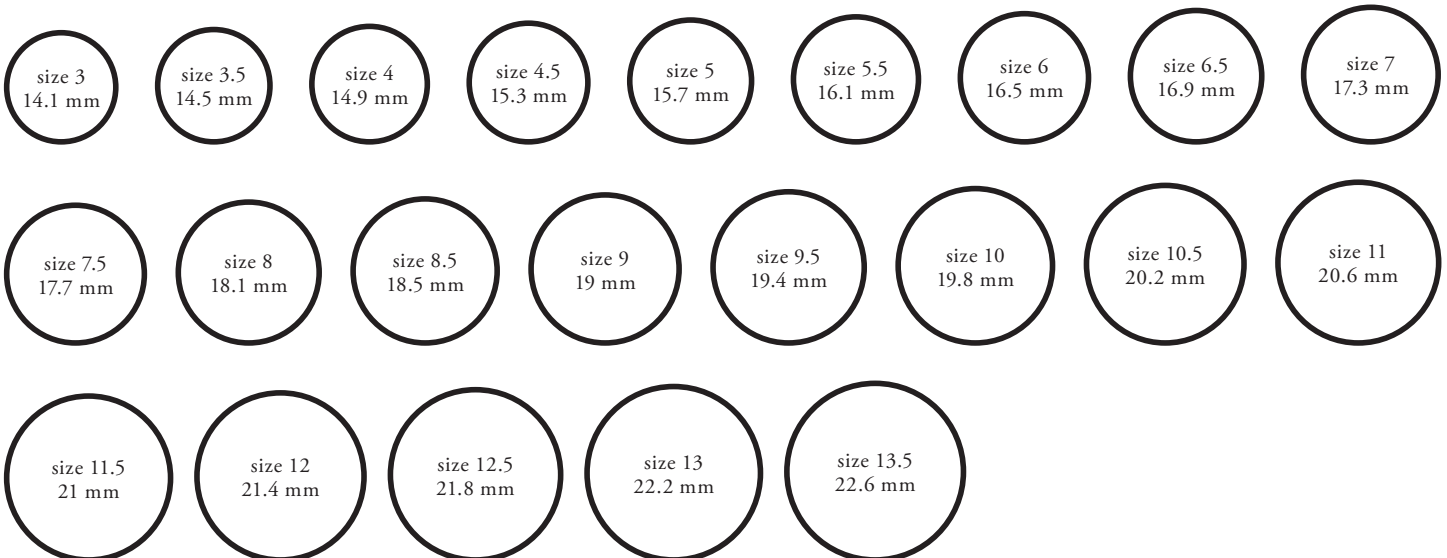
MEASURE CURRENT RING

1. Choose a ring that properly fits the intended finger.
2. Place the ring over the circles below, matching the inside edge of the ring to the circle nearest in size. This measurement refers to the inside diameter of the ring.
3. If the ring falls between two sizes, order the larger size.



Measurements match the **inside** edge of the ring.

CANADIAN & US RING SIZES:



We cannot guarantee that ring sizing via paper will be accurate. We highly recommend getting sized by a local jeweler.

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TIPS FOR MEASURING RING SIZE

MEASURING YOUR FINGER

You want your ring to be comfortable; tight enough so it won't fall off, but loose enough to slide over your knuckle with some resistance.

Finger size changes depending on the time of day and the weather. For best results measure your finger size:

1. At the end of the day and when your fingers are warm (Fingers are smaller in the early morning and when cold.)
2. Measure finger size 3 to 4 times to eliminate an erroneous reading.

Temperature is key

Don't measure when your body temperature is either too cold or too hot. A cold finger shrinks while a hot finger expands causing an inaccurate reading. Only measure when fingers are at room temperature. Also don't measure immediately after exercising.

When two sizes seem to fit

If you're torn between two sizes, always go with the larger one.

Big knuckles can affect your size

If your knuckle is a lot larger than the base of your finger, you may need to go up a half size.

A wider band needs a bigger size

If you are purchasing a wide band, you will be more comfortable moving up a size from your measurement.

RING SIZES IN CANADA

Women's rings typically range from size 3 to 9. The most commonly purchased women's ring sizes at So Pretty range from size 5 to 8 with Sizes 6 & 7 being the most popular ring sizes.

TIPS FOR BUYING THE RING AS A SURPRISE Borrow one of your significant other's rings (from the correct finger) and use the ring measurements on the first page to determine its size. We recommend measuring with a plain band. Please make sure beforehand that the ring you are purchasing can be resized. Rings with stones or patterns all the way around usually cannot be resized. Most other rings can be resized for a small fee.

For best results, measure a plain, narrow band

Extra wide band styles tend to run slightly small. If your borrowed ring has a narrower shaft than the one you wish to purchase, you may wish to order a ring a size larger than the normal size worn. Also, large stone rings may cause the shank to lift up when laid on its side on the display, slightly distorting the size measurements.

INTERNATIONAL SIZE CONVERSION

If ordering from outside of Canada or the US determine your ring size according to your country's standard. Then use the International Ring Size Chart to convert to the corresponding US ring size to place your order.
