Bugabaloo "How To..." Bunny Bottom Spring Planter!



Materials:

- 1- 4" Clay Pot, 3 1/2" High
- Small Styrofoam Ball (for inside the pot)
- Acrylic Paint (to decorate the pot)
- Felt: 1-Small Pink and 1- Medium Pom-Pom Colored
- 1- Large (3.5") Pom-Pom (Color to coordinate with felt)
- 1- Small (0.5") White Pom-Pom
- 1- Small Popsicle Stick
- Green Paper Crimps, Basket Grass, or Green Moss
- Small Decorative Artificial Flowers and Greens

TOOLS:

- "Tacky" craft glue or Low-temp Glue Gun & Glue Sticks
- Paint Brush, Sponges, or Paper Towels
- Sharp Multipurpose Scissors
- Optional: Tweezers

steps:

- 1. **FLOWER POT:** Lightly paint the clay pot and let it dry while you create the bunny's bottom and feet (Steps 2&3). Once the pot is dry, place the Styrofoam insert in the clay pot and cover it with craft grass or moss, gluing if necessary. Arrange your flowers and greens and insert into the grass or moss covered Styrofoam insert along the back side of the clay pot. Hint: You may find it easier to arrange and insert the flowers and greens once you've placed your bunny bottom in step two. Do whatever works best for you and your creativity!
- 2. BODY AND TAIL: Glue the popsicle stick to the center of the large pom-pom. This will be used as the stake that holds the bunny in the pot. Center the small pom-pom tail onto the large pom-pom and glue in place. You may need to trim the pom-poms slightly to make a flat surface for the glue. Fluff and trim the large pom-pom into a round bunny bottom shape if necessary. Carefully insert the popsicle stick and bunny bottom pom-pom into the clay pot and the grass or moss covered Styrofoam insert.
- 3. **FEET:** From the pom-pom colored felt, cut two bunny sized feet. Need help? We've included a pattern for you! From the pink felt, cut two large foot pads and six small foot pads and carefully glue on the felt feet. Hint: Tweezers might be helpful when positioning and gluing the tiny foot pads! Too many tiny pieces? Use acrylic paint for the pads if it's easier. Position the feet onto the bunny's bottom just above the pot rim, approximately 1 1/2" apart; and secure with glue.
