




This is a tutorial on how to access the CIF component of the course. You'll gain access to the CIF component and Coaching Principles online course at the same time. Slides one through six take you through the process of accessing your courses through our legacy site. Links and instructions for accessing your course are found in your "accessing your online course" email (shown above in the sample email box). If you've already accessed the Coaching Principles course, you can jump right to slide six.




This is the email providing information on accessing your online course. Again, note that you'll be taken to our "legacy" website to access and take your course.




Double click and copy the temporary password provided to you in this email. You'll use it to sign in on the legacy website. Next, click the "Access my online course" button. (If your email did not include a temporary password, that means you already have an account on the site. Click the "Access my online course" button to proceed.)



This is the sign in screen on the legacy site. Under “Sign in here if you have previously registered,” enter the email address you used to purchase your course and paste the temporary password you copied from the “Accessing your online course” email. Click “Sign in.”



Click the "Sign in" button to proceed. You may change your password anytime by clicking on the "Edit profile" text link from the top of the page (shown on the following screen).



The courses that were purchased (in this case, CIF Coaching Principles and the CIF state test) are listed under “Incomplete courses.” Under “Test status” there’s a link to “Take test.” Click the “Take test” link to access the course/test.

You'll need to know and comply with the information in the California Interscholastic Federation Coaching Education Study Guide to be a successful high school coach and to pass this test. If you haven't already reviewed this resource, open it now and become familiar with it before completing your test. Because you may want to refer to this document on the job, consider saving and/or printing this document.

To successfully complete the test, you must pass with a score of 80% or higher. The test contains 34 Multiple Choice and 16 True/False questions.

After you click Submit at the end of each section's questions, your answers will be saved. You will NOT be able to go back to change answers. Questions left unanswered will be scored as incorrect. Feedback on your answers will not be provided until you have completed the entire test.

After you finish the last section, your answers will be graded electronically and you will see your score, your pass/fail status, and a listing of the questions you missed. If you do not pass the test, you can take a retest for an additional \$10 fee.

You have 6 months from the date you first access the test to obtain a passing score. After that time the test will not be available without an additional fee.

**1. For a student to be eligible for athletic participation, he or she must have a minimum 2.0 GPA in**

- a. every grading period throughout school
- b. the grading period immediately prior to athletic participation
- c. there is no minimum 2.0 GPA; districts and schools may establish any GPA requirement
- d. 2.0 GPA is only required for varsity level competition


**2. Students are allowed the following number of consecutive semesters of eligibility:**

- a. eight (8) consecutive semesters from their initial enrollment in ninth grade

On this page, click the link to access the CIF bylaws (PDF document). You'll refer to this document as you answer the test questions. There are 40 questions on the CIF bylaws test.



This is a screen shot of the CIF document you'll use to complete the test questions. You'll toggle between the PDF and the test windows while taking the test.



After completing the 40 questions, click the “submit” button to submit your answers. Your test will be scored immediately.
