

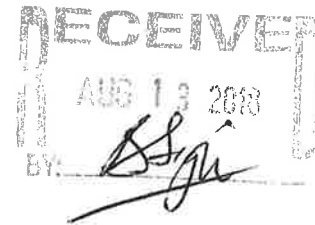

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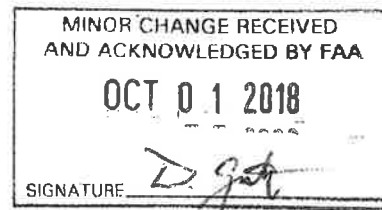

Subject: S-51200/51250-(), Model AV-35B Life Preserver, Minor Change Request

Dear Mr. Dickert,

The life preserver drawing S-51200/51250-() has had a minor change to it. Revision Q and this letter are being submitted to bring our records up to date.

Revision Q, dated 7/18, allows for the use of an alternate cylinder cover (item 27) for all life preserver assemblies. This cover was already in use on two variations of the life preserver. Sheet 1 shows a new illustration of the alternate cover. Sheet 2 adds an item callout for the cover next to the item callout for the original cover in Section N-N. Sheet 3 adds Note 20 which states that the alternate cover may be used in lieu of the original cover. The word "DRAWING" was corrected to "DONNING" in Note 7. In Note 9, two items of thread (item 28) had their Factory Codes changed to Part Numbers. The Bill of Materials was updated to remove extraneous information that is already listed on lower level drawings. No actual changes to any materials were made. The drawing tolerance was changed from S-1346 to S-1448. The new tolerance drawing is more appropriate for textiles.

Switlik has reviewed the design change, and all applicable data, and consider this a minor change per 14 CFR Part 21, Subpart O, §21.619 and as defined in our quality control manual. Additionally, as no change was actually made to the FAA-approved life preserver, it does not require a substantially complete investigation to determine compliance with TSO-C13d, and its ability to meet the minimum performance standards of Appendix 1, is unaffected.

We hereby certify that this life preserver meets or exceeds all the requirements of TSO C13d, complies with 14 CFR Part 21, Subpart O, and will be manufactured under the strict quality control procedures on file with your Saddle Brook, New Jersey office.
