



Subject: P/N S-9450-(), Model EV-35 Life Preserver Minor Change Request

Dear Mr. Dickert,

The life preserver drawing S-9450-() has had one minor change to it. Revision E and this letter are being submitted to bring our records up to date.

Revision E, dated 5/18, added a new color to Note 3. Note 3 designates the last digit of the Aviator series life preservers with a number to indicate the color of the jacket assembly. The new color is International Orange and is represented by the number "4". The material, itself, is Nomex® and meets the fire protection requirements of TSO-C13f, Appendix 1, 5.1.

Additionally, the drawing title was changed from "Encapsulated Vest" to "Aviator Vest".

Switlik has reviewed the design change, and all applicable data, and consider this a minor change per 14 CFR Part 21, Subpart O, §21.619 and as defined in our quality control manual. Additionally, as no change was actually made to the FAA-approved life preserver, it does not require a substantially complete investigation to determine compliance with TSO-C13f, and its ability to meet the minimum performance standards of Appendix 1, is unaffected.

We hereby certify that this life preserver meets or exceeds all the requirements of TSO C13f, complies with 14 CFR Part 21, Subpart O, and will be manufactured under the strict quality control procedures on file with your Saddle Brook, New Jersey office.
