

The McAlson mask is produced in accordance with Belgian standards: NBN / DTD S 65-001: 2020 "Multiface community masks".

Wearing these masks is limited to 4 hours. Do not change the side without first washing the mask.

Its purpose is to form a barrier and to stop possible viral penetration into the mouth and nose of the wearer or a person nearby. These masks are not designed to protect the lungs from hazards in the air. They are designed to avoid touching your mouth and nose. They are also designed to minimize saliva spattering as much as possible when talking, coughing or sneezing. The use of the "community" or artisanal mask is envisaged, for example, for a person leaving their home to go to the place of exercise of professional activity or to do their shopping. The rules of social distancing apply despite the use of "community" or artisan masks.

The mask does not in any way exempt the wearer from the application of barrier gestures supplemented by the social distancing measure which are essential.

This product should only be used by children over 3 years of age due to the risk of suffocation and children should be supervised while wearing this product.

Please note: a mouth mask certainly does not allow intense effort, such as intensive sport practice.

This device is not a medical device within the meaning of Regulation (EU) 2017/745 / Directive 93/42 / EEC nor personal protective equipment within the meaning of Regulation (EU) 2016/425.

Washing :

- It is recommended to wash the mask used as soon as possible, but at least every day and after 4 hours of wearing.
- Clean the mask before first use.
- No specific product other than a neutral detergent should be used, preferably without fabric softener.
- Masks are always washed separately with additional ballast (eg a used bath towel) in order to generate a mechanical cleaning action.
- For disinfection, a temperature of at least 60 ° C during washing should be maintained for 30 minutes.

Instructions for wearing the mask



1. Wash your hands with soap and water before touching the mask
2. Check the mask to make sure there are no holes or tears
3. Hold the mask with the rigid foldable band (if applicable) facing up and the colored side (if applicable) outward.
4. Put on the mask according to the type of mask you are using:
5. Face mask with elastic ear loops: Hold both elastic loops, stretch them gently and hook them behind the ears so that the mask covers the nose, mouth and chin.



1. Wash your hands with soap and water before touching the mask
2. Do not touch the front of the mask as it may be contaminated. Only touch the ear loops / bands
3. Remove the mask: hold the two ear loops, loosen them and gently lift them to remove the mask.
4. Wash your hands with soap and water before touching anything else.
