## HAT SIZES:

People vary primarily in height and width. The East Germans took this into account in a very special way, combining the European sizing system numbers with German language and East German specialties.

CLOTHING SIZES
A basic rule of thumb to follow is that VINTAGE sizes are at least four sizes smaller than modern sizes. The further back in time you go, the smaller the clothes get, and you may have to adjust up another size or two.

Widths are like normal European sizing widths, except they do not affect length, and some sizes are left out to simplify things. As a special touch suffix numbers are used to account for different body types, for an example SK48-0 or G52-1. These add or subtract 8 cm (a wee bit short of 3 ") from the waist as follows:

- $0=-8 \mathrm{~cm}$, Athletic body with slender waist
- No suffix = No effect, normal body type
- $1=+8 \mathrm{~cm}$, Dad body
- $2=+16 \mathrm{~cm}$, Beer belly


## Lengths

Lengths are determined by letter codes. They are short for German words Sehr Klein, Klein, Mittelgroß, Groß, Sehr Groß and Übergroß. Here's what they mean:
