Zen Minimal Theme:


Consider that light colors (for example pure white, or the Zen Minimal Theme above), especially when used outdoors, will show dirt more quickly if they are not protected by a tent or roof overhead. We can provide white, or bright colors (like Spectrum Daffodil), but for that reason we don't show many of them in the recommended samples.

The next page of tweeds are popular, because two-tone fabrics generally require the least care of all. They are better at hiding dirt, tree leaves or debris over the long term, if you want the lowest maintenance possible.
This can be especially useful on an outdoor Bed.
You can use them singly or mix and match, as before.

These 2 solids require less frequent cleaning than white for outdoor use, if you want a light color.

The two most natural-looking colors for the shade sails are cream and bamboo.
(The other 3 color shade sails are available as well - red, blue and green - but they look cheaper, more "synthetic" in person, and you probably won't like them.)
