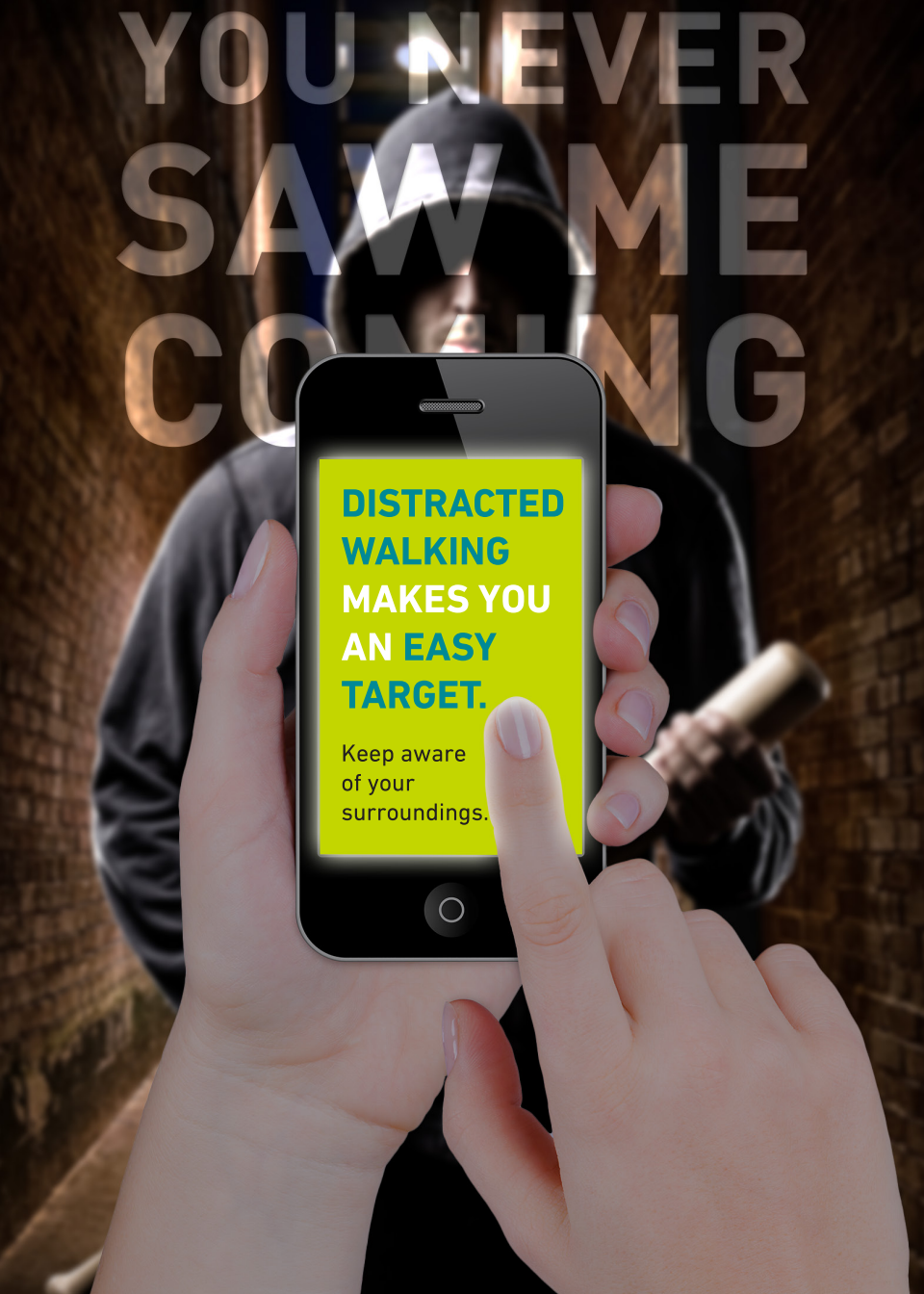

1 in 3 robberies in the U.S. involved a mobile communications device, making it the #1 property crime in the country.

So how do you protect yourself?

We care about your safety. Please follow these simple steps when out in public with your mobile phone:

1. Be aware of your surroundings. Being distracted when you're on your phone makes you an easy target for cell phone thieves.
2. Password-protect your phone. A password may not prevent your cell phone from being stolen, but if your device is taken, a thief won't have easy access to any private information stored on your phone.
3. Know how to identify your phone. Write down your phone's model number, serial number, and unique ID number (or IMEI number.)
4. Install anti-theft software. An anti-theft app will allow you to track your phone, locate it if it's lost, as well as remotely wipe the information on it.
5. Know who to call. If your mobile phone is stolen, call your carrier to temporarily suspend your service and file a police report immediately.
