2 PARTS WATER 1 PART WHITE VINEGAR 2 DROPS LAVENDER OIL 1 DROP TEA TREE OIL

MIX ALL 3 INGREDIENTS IN A SPRAY BOTTLE

# YOUR MATTRESS

Strip your bed & rotate your mattress 180 degrees. Clean stains with a natural cleaner, effective on bacteria but easy on fabric. Thoroughly vacuum & wash under the bed & boxspring. Leave the windows wide open, with the curtains fully drawn to air out your mattress & take advantage of the sun's anti-microbial powers.

# YOUR PILLOWS

Strip your pillows & treat any staining with a natural cleaner. Wash your pillows, 2 at a time, on a delicate cycle, warm water, very little detergent & no bleach or softener.

Dry pillows individually on a medium setting, along with 2 tennis balls. Puff it up & dry again for a second cycle.

Fold the pillow in half, if it doesn't start to unfold itself - chuck it!

#### YOUR DUVET

Strip your duvet & wash it - delicate cycle, warm water, very little detergent & no bleach or softener!

Shake out your duvet & tumble dry on a medium setting. Shake it out & dry again for a second cycle.

Take advantage of the bright, hot sun & hang your duvet out on the line for an added fresh feel & scent.

### YOUR PROTECTORS

Pillow & mattress protectors are vital in maintaining the cleanliness & lifespan of your product.

Launder them according to the manufacturer's guidelines. Never use bleach as it breaks down waterproof & bacteria barriers.

# YOUR LINENS

Launder your bed linens as suggested by the manufacturer. Replace torn or worn pieces. Upgrade if your past linens haven't made the cut. Well made sheets should last you at least a decade. Dry clean or hand wash decorative accessories and coverlets.
