

MARBLE

Marble is a metamorphic rock composed of many compressed layers over millions of years. The naturally occurring patterns, fissures and tones vary from piece to piece. For example, the taupe marble contains natural hardened fissures that appear to be cracks but are not. These markings are natural and unavoidable. Our marble has a polyester resin laminate coating on the top to reduce staining. The underside is reinforced with a fibreglass mesh for added strength. Marble thickness may vary slightly.

MARBLE CARE

Immediately wipe up any spilled liquids or food with a damp cloth. Mild soaps can be used for greasy residue. Never use aggressive chemical cleaners. Never place hot pots directly on marble. Marble is easily chipped; take care to avoid hard hits. Soft coasters and placemats are recommended. For indoor use only. Do not sit or stand on marble tables.

MARBLE HANDLING

CAUTION: Marble tops should always be stored, carried and transported upright on their long edge. Use appropriate manpower and equipment to move heavy marble to prevent breakage.

WARRANTIES

Marble and frames are warrantied for one year, under normal residential use. Warranty does not cover discolouration of stone that has not been protected from direct, unfiltered light. Warranty will not extend to any piece that is not stored or moved with adequate care and equipment in an upright position.
