

JABC What's In My Hoop—Featuring Button Lover's Club HAUNT CUISINE

The HAUNT CUISINE Button Lover's Club tin was inspired by our bubbling cauldron button. Just imagine the spooky ingredients that would tint the contents that poison-purple color. This embroidery design features buttons from the September 2021 tin, but you could use—or add—other Halloween buttons from your stash.

The tiny purple buttons are included in your Button Lover's Club tin. They look just like bubbles! We added the poison punch button from our stash. Find it [HERE](#).



Supplies:

- Button Lover's Club HAUNT CUISINE tin
- [Poison Punch button](#) (sold separately)
- Black embroidery floss
- Green cotton fabric, 10" square
- 4" Wood embroidery hoop
- Needle and coordinating thread
- Scissors
- Pencil

Instructions:

- With a pencil, lightly trace the full-size pattern in the center of the fabric square. The circle on the pattern shows the position of the words in the hoop. It's not necessary to trace the circle.
- Snap the fabric in your hoop.
- With two strands of floss, embroider Haunt Cuisine with split stitch and the smaller words with back stitch. Split stitch results in a slightly heavier line. Sew the buttons in place using matching thread. Check out our Snug-A-Button Stitch School Tutorial for a fool-proof technique for stitching the buttons in place. - Trim away the extra fabric, leaving 1 1/4". Sew a long running stitch all around, 1/4" in from the cut edge. Don't cut the thread. Flip over the hoop and gather the excess fabric to the back by pulling gently on the running stitches. Knot the thread.
