# On the Hunt Mini Quilt Supplies:

## [Button Lover's Club: Words with Buttons](#)

(HUNT Box)

Fabric (Fox Farm by Melissa Mortenson for

Riley Blake shown + Riley Blake Shades):

- 15¾ x 11¾" mint textured solid (for block background)
- 1½ x 2" mint textured solid
- 11¾ x 2½" wellie print
- 7½ x 7½" red print
- 2½ x 3" navy floral print
- 8½ x 8" navy sheep print
- 2½ x 3" white sheep print
- 4 x 6½" white textured solid
- 4 x 4½" brown textured solid
- 5½ x 6" dark blue solid
- 4¾ x 12" mint dog print
- (2) 2½ x 17½" mint textured solid (borders)
- (2) 2½ x 15½" mint textured solid (borders)
- 16 x 22" mint print (backing)
- 85" mint binding (bias is not necessary)

# On the Hunt Mini Quilt Instructions:

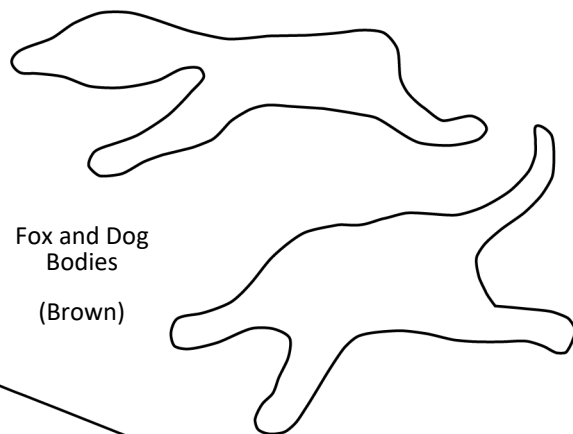
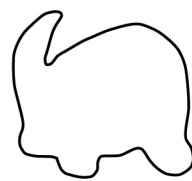
1. Trace the applique shapes onto Fusi-bond Lite.
2. Following the package directions on the Fusi-bond Lite, iron the traced shapes onto the back sides of the corresponding fabrics.
3. Cut out the shapes.
4. Arrange the shapes onto the block backgrounds and fuse in place.
5. Applique all of the shapes. We used a straight, machine stitch close to the edge of the shapes.
6. Press the block.
7. Sew the 11¾ x 2½" navy wellie fabric to the bottom of the applique block background.
8. Sew the 2½ x 17½" borders to the left and right sides of the mini quilt. Press the seams toward the borders.
9. Then sew the 2½ x 15½" borders to the top and bottom of the runner. Press the seams toward the borders. Trim the borders to square the mini quilt.
10. Layer the mini quilt top on the fusible fleece and fuse in place. Add the backing to the bottom and use safety pins to hold the layers together.
11. Quilt as desired and bind. Add an embroidered line below the rooster applique to create the look of a weather vane.
12. Sew buttons to the mini quilt (see the picture for suggested placement).

## Appliqué Patterns:

Trace the shapes onto the paper side of the fusible and then iron, with the shiny side down, to the wrong side of your fabric.

These shapes have been reversed.

The hill shape is split between pages 4 and 5. Tape the two sections together before tracing. They overlap by 1".
