Liquor Licensing Act 1997

LICENSED PREMISES: Outlined in red on the approved plan

AUTHORISATION: To sell and supply liquor in accordance with Section 39 of the Liquor Licensing Act 1997 and any other conditions of this licence

TRADING HOURS: Areas 1 & 5
Monday to Sunday 10am to 11.30pm
Areas 2 to 4
Monday to Sunday 10am to 5pm
With the exception of 12 functions a year for pre-arranged tastings in the Southern Cellar Door in which case the operating hours are 10am to 10.30pm

DESIGNATED AREAS: Dining: Outlined in green on the plan and shown as Areas 1 & 5

SAMPLING AREAS: Outlined in yellow on the plan and shown as Areas 1 to 5

CONSUMPTION ON PREMISES: Under section 39(1)(e) of the Act the licensee is authorised to sell the licensee's product for consumption on the licensed premises in the area outlined in broken yellow on the approved plan and shown as Areas 1 to 5. It is a condition of this approval that the licensee must have food available for consumption on the premises either on a complimentary basis or for patrons to purchase when liquor is sold pursuant to section 39(1)(e).

The overall capacity shall not exceed 125 persons at any one time

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LIQUOR AND GAMBLING COMMISSIONER

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RESPONSIBLE PERSONS: Under Section 97(2) of the Act an exemption is granted from the requirements of subsection (1)(a)

CONDITIONS:

1. Under Section 42(2)(b) of the Act, the licensee is authorised to dispatch liquor from premises other than the licensed premises. Details of all dispatch sites must be made available for inspection by an authorised Officer.
2. The licence authorises the sale of liquor produced by the licensee either personally or under contract. Details of all contracts entered into must be available for inspection by an authorised officer.

Conditions applicable to Areas 1 & 5:

3. The number of functions/events in a calendar year shall not exceed 50.
4. All functions or events shall be held within the months of October to April in a calendar year, with the exception of the 2 regional wine events.
5. The function centre shall not hold a function or event when one or both of the cellar doors on the site is/are open for trade.



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
