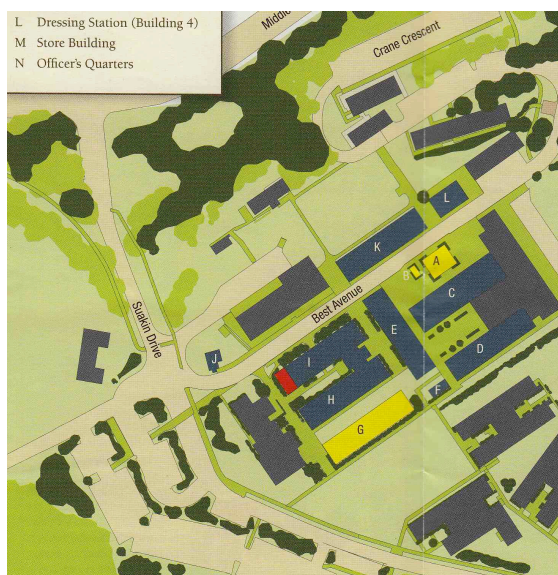

HISTORY AND SNAGS AT GEORGES HEIGHTS

Join us for a tour at Georges Heights. Our guides are Mosman Historical Society members. They will take participants to various sites associated with the area's fascinating military history and tell their stories.

The tour takes about an hour. There is some easy walking over mainly flat ground.

Following the tour, John Dansie provides one of his famous sausage sizzles. If you prefer, you can have your own picnic. You may also wish to bring drinks and chairs. Please note, however, that the end of the tour and the sausage sizzle are in the artists' precinct, at least a five-minute walk from where the tour commences.
