***HISTORY AND SNAGS AT BALAKLAVA
(MOSMAN JUNCTION)***

Join us for a walking tour around the proposed village of Balaklava (so named during the early 1870s). Our guides are Mosman Historical Society members. They will take participants to various places associated with the area's fascinating history and tell their stories. Places to be visited or viewed from a distance include Mosman Municipal Library's original site, the post office, Scots Kirk, Mosman Bowling Club, Muston's Model Village site, Mosman High School, the Dom Lopez bust and the former Lopez shop, the tram waiting shed site, Leaheys Real Estate building, the 1908 building, the Richard Harnett bust, the Buena (formerly Buena Vista) Hotel, Mosman Police Station, and Hampshire Park.

The tour takes about an hour. There is easy walking over flat ground.

Following the tour, John Dansie provides one of his famous sausage sizzles at Hampshire Park. If you prefer, you can have your own picnic. You may also wish to bring drinks and chairs.

There is no need to book.
