It includes revealing memories of older Mosman residents such as travelling by tram on the steep descent to Balmoral, playing in the bush at Middle Head during the Second World War, milk being delivered by horse and cart, visiting Mosman's once numerous milk bars to buy musk sticks and drink 'spiders', and the service station near the Buena Vista Hotel selling five or six brands of petrol.

One of three Probus members responsible for bringing the book to fruition, Margaret had a long career in senior administration and management. She has published many books of her own and in her retirement helps other authors to self-publish. She has a particular passion for family history.
